Some Questions that people bring to spiritual direction:

COME SIT WITH ME

HOW IS GOD

LEADING YOU?

- Why doesn't God hear my prayers?
- How should I pray?
- Who is God for me?
- Where is God when I suffer?
- How do I go "deeper" into my prayer?

What is spiritual direction? "It is a form of soul care which offers an individual the opportunity to meet with another Christian for the purpose of examining his/her relationship with God." ~ Dahlia Fraser

It may be a new idea for you but it is an ancient tradition in Christianity available to everyone

"A spiritual director is, then, one who helps another to recognize and to follow the inspirations of grace in their life, in order to arrive at the end to which God is leading."

~Thomas Merton

THE WHO, WHAT, WHEN, AND WHERE OF IT?

The who: Just you and a spiritual companion or "soul friend" called a spiritual director.

The what: A confidential conversation where you can talk freely about your spiritual thoughts, needs, and experiences.

When and Where: In spiritual direction, you would meet with a director typically once a month. Meetings usually last about an hour and bring a "God focus" to your life concerns and events.

How long does it go on? It could be for a few months, years, or intermittently/ "Whenever it is helpful."

Where? We meet in the parish office or by video call.

What it is not: It is not counseling or therapy, problem solving or theological discussion, religious education or Bible study, though these may come up. Rather it is directed at the question: Where is God in your life?

"The goal of spiritual direction is...the ever increasing capacity to live a spiritual life from the heart."
