

A Letter From The Pastor...

The 4th of July has always been one of my favorite holidays. Every year my family would go to my aunt's and uncle's house on the north shore of Long Island and spend the day with family and friends. We swam, ate, caught up with cousins we had not seen in a while, and, did I mention we ate? The food was always plentiful and delicious! At the end of the day, the big question was always, do we wait for the

fireworks and add an hour to our ride home or leave early and beat the crowds? That was way above my pay grade so that decision was left to my mom and dad. Most of the time mom won and we stayed for the fireworks. Fifty-some years later my family still gathers at my aunt's and uncle's house, now my cousin's house, as the tradition continues. I am sorry when I am unable to join them, but, I do have to say, it is great to be on LBI on the 4th of July Weekend!

On behalf of the Pastoral Staff, welcome to all of our visitors this weekend. You are always welcome at St. Francis of Assisi Parish and in all of our churches: St. Francis of Assisi, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Thomas of Villanova, and St. Clare of Assisi. You should find a welcome letter in the pews or at the doors of the churches. If you would like to become more involved in our parish community, simply answer a few questions and return it to me online or in the usher's basket. The invitation is also extended to our "regular" parishioners if you are year round or here for the summer. If you would like to become more involved in the parish, I would encourage you to also return the form.

Despite this weekend's celebrations, we also know that something isn't right in the world. You may have noticed a police car in front of St. Francis last weekend. Last Thursday I met with the Long Beach Township Police Chef Kevin Mahon and Capt. Ed Bernhard to discuss how we can make sure the parish and center are safe for everyone. Wendy Saunders, the Ex. Dir. of the St. Francis Center, Dan Rodriguez, Dir. of Maintenance, and Amy Bodine, Dir. of HR, joined the conversation. The meeting was called because of the recurrence of shootings in our country.

On Tuesday, June 28th, the church remembered St. Irenaeus of Lyon. He was born in the Greek city of Smyrna [present day Izmir, Turkey] in the year 130 AD and was martyred toward the end of the second or the beginning of the third century. The Roman Empire was the superpower at the time and Christians were being persecuted for their beliefs. He lived in a very dangerous time. He was made the bishop of Lugdunum, now Lyon, France, and is noted for his great role in evangelizing that region. He is also remembered for his great contributions to the development of our Christian theology.

In January of this year, Pope Francis conferred the title of *Doctor of the Church* on St. Irenaeus. In the decree, Pope Francis wrote, "St. Irenaeus of Lyon, who came from the East, exercised his episcopal ministry in the West: he was a spiritual and theological bridge between Eastern and Western Christians. His name, Irenaeus, expresses that peace which comes from the Lord and which reconciles, reintegrating into unity. In granting him this privileged place in our church, Pope Francis gave St. Irenaeus the title, *Doctor Unitatis.* [Doctor of Unity]

With the current realities in the back of my mind, it is no wonder that I was struck by the closing prayer at Tuesday's morning prayer: "Father, you called St. Irenaeus to uphold your truth and bring peace to your Church. By his prayers renew us in faith and love that we may always be intent on fostering unity and peace."

We live in a great country. We are blessed in so many ways. We have freedoms that most of the world envies yet we also live in a divided land. I ask you to join me in prayer, through the intercession of St. Irenaeus, that we may find that balance of upholding truth and bringing peace in our Church, to our country, and to our world and that we may be renewed in our faith and in our love so that we may always foster the unity and peace that makes this country so great.

May God continue to bless us all with peace.

Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

Celiac Disease and Holy Eucharist





Weekly Reflections...

Holiness

Not too long ago, the Parish Council invited us to participate in a parish survey which most of us responded with truth and honesty. But who are we beyond the immediate and obvious name, address, parish envelope number? We are holy people, chosen by God and sent forth to live the kingdom of

Pope Francis in his exhortation "Call to Holiness" reminds us that by Baptism all are called to holiness. As the Body of Christ, a community of memory and hope, we are called to create a "God enlightened space where the presence of the risen Lord" is experienced. "Growth in holiness is a call to journey, side by side, with others". Sharing God's Word and celebrating the Eucharist together fosters a relationship that makes us holy people. Life whether it is in the family, the parish, or in religious community is made up of small ordinary things. This was true of the Holy Family formed by Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It was true also of the life that Jesus shared with his disciples. It is the life of ordinary people. It is the life of the Church. We remember Jesus asked his disciples to pay attention to details like: the wine was running out at a party that one sheep was missing noticing the widow who offered two small coins having a fire burning and fish cooking as he waited for the disciples at daybreak. Pope Francis points out the signs of holiness in today's world are "patience, perseverance, meekness, joy and a sense of humor". Sometimes we do not see the "holy" in ourselves. (especially in this time of pandemic). Scripture reminds us that "we do not see as God sees". Each day we see human needs and try to make a difference. It may be simply wiping away the tear on a child's face or as demanding as caring for an ageing parent. True holiness is discipleship. It is an attitude of joyful service of others, it does not ask what is in this for me. Only in imitating the servanthood of Christ do we experience the true depth of faith. Only by embracing Christ's compassion and humility in our lives do we enable the Spirit to transform us in God's love and grace. The gospel values of our Baptism call us to be holy to be a healing presence to the loneliness of a suffering world. With one another in relationship, whether it be in the virtual world or the real world, we are reminded to let our light shine for behold God is making all things new! It is with gratitude that we live this holy life.


