Ash Wednesday, Parish & Center Closings, & Covid Vaccine

Ash Wednesday is February 17th. We will be distributing ashes in a way that will be safe for everyone at our 3 Ash Wednesday Prayer Service: 7:30 AM, noon, and 5:30 PM. Ashes will also be distributed at the 9:00 AM. Mass. Please check the bulletin for more details.

Having arrived from St. Bonaventure University I was accustomed to lots of snow and deep cold. Here, however, we don't have to worry so much about the inches of snow but the feet of water above high tide when storms come barreling through. When we close the Parish & Center it is usually because the boulevard is, or is predicted to be, impassable and dangerous.

At times the Parish & Center would be closed, yet, we would still have the 9:00 AM Mass. The friars and I discussed this, and we believe that if a danger exists to close the Parish & Center, it will also exist for those trying to get to the 9:00 AM Mass as well. For that reason, we will not celebrate the 9:00 AM Daily Mass if the Parish & Center are closed due to inclement weather. We do not want anyone to have to second guess if there will be Mass or not. The intentions for that Mass will be moved to the next day Mass is offered.

We will continue to use our Facebook page, parish website, and radio announcements to let you know if we will be closed. We will also be using a text messaging service, *RainedOut*, for a more convenient and faster way to spread the news. The only thing... and there is always a thing... you do need to sign up online if you wish to receive an email or text [or both.]

Don't worry, it's fairly straight forward and easy to do. If you do have any issues signing up, find someone younger than 15. I'm convinced it's their first language!

Here are the simple steps you will need to follow.

- 1) Go to *rainedout.com*
- 2) Click on the yellow box "Receive Messages"
- 3) In the dialogue box above the word "Search" type in LBICC. St. Francis Center, LBICC Inc. will appear.
- 4) Click on St. Francis Center, LBICC [in blue]
- 5) Click, Continue. Do not worry about the fee. The emails are free. The Parish & Center will pick up the cost if you choose to receive texts.
- 6) Click the box "Agree to Terms of Service."
- 7) Add your email address or your phone number in the appropriate box and click "Start Signup."
- 8) Rained out will send you a validation code to your phone or email address. To confirm the set up you will need to type that code on the website page. Done! Simple! Good!

Covid Vaccine: Perhaps you know this already, but on February 4th, St. Francis Parish & Center began hosting the LBI Health Department in the Brant Beach Church Hall as they continue their great effort to distribute the Covid-19 vaccine to our entire community. I would encourage everyone to get the vaccine. Because we do visit the sick the friars and Sr. Pat have begun the two-stage process. It was very easy.

You will need to sign up at www.lbihealth.com for an appointment. Click on the words "Covid-19" on the top right corner of their home page. The page has the latest information regarding Covid-19. On the bottom of the page, you will see "Register with V-Safe." That will take you through the steps to sign up for a vaccine. The LBI Health Department will continue to post appointments based on the quantity of vaccines they receive.

We do know that the roll-out of the vaccine has been chaotic throughout the country. Fortunately, it does seem that things are being put into place for a smoother road ahead. We pray for patience and fortitude.

Since this is a LBI Heath Department initiative *I ask that you NOT call the Parish or Center* if you have any Covid related questions. Please visit their website or reach out to health department directly at (609) 492 1212.

We continue to pray for an end to the pandemic as we also offer prayers of gratitude for all of our first responders, health care workers, scientists, and everyone helping us all to heal and move beyond Covid.

Weekly Reflections...

"Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God, and saying, 'The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is near; repent, and believe in the good news'" (Mark 1:14-15)

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of a nearly 95 day long journey through lent, the Triduum, and the Easter season which ends on Pentecost Sunday. For such a long trip we need nourishment and this year perhaps we need more than ever. Like all journeys, our trip begins with a single step. Many choose to begin by wearing ashes. We fast, care for others, and quietly offer alms. Rituals, psalms and penance are all part of our lenten journey. We long for these spiritual actions to not just be who we are during lent, but to become spiritual habits for a lifetime. We are called to conversion and we pray that we come to a closer personal relationship with God and with our brothers and sisters through our actions and prayers.

Through his Lenten messages and homilies, Pope Francis offers us guidance on some of the actions we can do for Lent: prayer, evangelize, help the poor, and take part in the sacraments. We will also share Lenten Journey Gospel Challenges on the covers of our church bulletins for the 5 weeks of Lent.

Lenten Regulations

- 1. The days of FAST (only one full meal) and ABSTINENCE (no meat) are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. No dispensations are granted on these solemn days except for reason of sickness or those provided in canon law below. The pastor of a parish has the authority to give a dispensation to individual parishioners in his parish. The Bishop alone has the authority to dispense groups of Catholics but only for a serious reason.
- 2. Those who are automatically dispensed from fast and abstinence regulations outside the age limits noted below include: the physically or mentally ill, especially individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also included in the dispensation are women who are pregnant or nursing. In all cases, common sense should prevail and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops).

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to FAST (only one full meal) as above. From the age of 14, people are also obliged to ABSTAIN (no meat: this obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat).
