



<u>Marriage</u>: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

Weekly Reflections...

Who Am I?

Who am I ... really? Beyond the immediate and the obvious... such as name and family, age and address, Social Security number ...who am I?

To the "Who am I question", the Church traditionally responds, "You are the Baptized". Baptism we are initiated, crowned, chosen, embraced, washed, adopted, gifted, reborn and sent forth redeemed. We are God's own sent forth to live the kingdom of God!

Who am I? You are someone to whom a name is given. At our birth our family gives us a name. A name is a gift. Life then is a long process of growing into this name, answering to it, and giving it meaning by the way we live our lives. So too at our Baptism we are given the name Christian. In Baptism the unmerited gift of grace (God's life) is bestowed on us. Daily we live this gift as we go about our ordinary activities. We discover what it means to be called "Christian" and grow into what we already are... the children of God.

Who am I? Baptism reminds us that we not only bear the name of Christian but we are also royalty! When I think of royalty, I think of Prince George of England born just a few years ago... so young yet so royal... someday to be King! He did nothing to earn or merit royalty. The same is ours in Baptism where we are anointed priest, prophet and king and gifted with the Spirit! We are God's holy people and we are called to proclaim the kingdom of peace and justice to everyone. As long as any of God's children suffer injustice, the "kingdom" is not finished and God's royal image in not clearly visible in us nor in the world around us.

In the midst of daily living it is so easy to forget who we are. The Church reminds us that we have been bought at a great price, that God has named us and claimed us, seeks us and loves us with only one good reason in mind... that we might be loved for all eternity. Today the Gospel reminds us of who Jesus is. Today let us remember that Baptism begins our transformation into Christ....and be grateful for WHO WE ARE AND WHO WE ARE BECOMING. Peace and All Good!



Lenten Regulations

- 1. The days of **FAST** (*only one full meal*) and **ABSTINENCE** (*no meat*) are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. No dispensations are granted on these solemn days except for reason of sickness or those provided in canon law below. The pastor of a parish has the authority to give a dispensation to individual parishioners in his parish. The Bishop alone has the authority to dispense groups of Catholics but only for a serious reason.
- 2. Those who are automatically dispensed from fast and abstinence regulations outside the age limits noted below include: the physically or mentally ill, especially individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also included in the dispensation are women who are pregnant or nursing. In all cases, common sense should prevail and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops).

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to FAST (only one full meal) as above. From the age of 14, people are also obliged to ABSTAIN (no meat: this obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat).


