Happy Father's Day

A Happy Father's Day to all of our dads!! Did you know that Father's Day did not become a federal holiday until 1972? The beginnings of Mother's Day go back to the late 1860's after the civil war. It became a federal holiday in 1914. According to the History Channel, the State of Washington was the first state to have a statewide celebration of Father's Day in 1910. That came about because Sonora

Smart Dodd wanted to establish an official equivalent to Mother's Day because she recognized the heroic actions of her widowed father who raised her and her five siblings. The idea of celebrating fathers slowly caught on and in 1924, President Calvin Coolidge urged state governments to observe Father's Day but it wasn't until 1972 that Father's Day become a federal holiday.

Interest to note is that in Europe and Latin America fathers are usually honored on March 19th, the Feast of St. Joseph. If you think it took a long time for fathers to be recognized in the United States, it wasn't until May 2013 that St. Joseph was finally added to the Eucharistic Prayers of our Church. Tradition has always told us that St. Joseph was a very patient father.

Many blessings on all of our fathers and all those father figures in our lives. May God continue to bless you all with Peace and All Good.




