

Thus, one often sees a picture of three chairs to symbolize the process, one for the director, one for the seeker and one for the Spirit! An Invitation to Contemplative Living





Additionally, the viscosity of water slows movement and provides resistance during exercise, making aquatic exercise a great workout.
