We Meet Lots of People Along the Way

We meet a lot of people here on Long Beach Island. Not too long ago, my niece called me and asked, "How far do you live from The Black Whale; You have to go there!" Her question and command were all in one breath. That was the night Taylor Swift was in town, and Beach

Haven turned into a mob scene. Although her visit to LBI made local and perhaps even national news, it did not excite me.

At the end of Mass last weekend, a very nice young couple introduced themselves to me. They explained they were from New Hampshire, and their mother/mother-in-law was from Houston. We laughed about the two extremes, New Hampshire and Texas, meeting in the "middle" right here in New Jersey.



Mary, may the gift of the Holy Spirit intercede for me: sustain my weakness; breathe into my heart the consolation that I may leave traces of faith among the young,




