Center had been neglected for so long. It was so overgrown and was in need of a good overhaul. The confirmation for that was after many of the overgrown plants were removed someone asked me when we got the statue of St. Francis in front of the pool. I smiled and said that it had been there for almost 20 years. The gardens around the church had also became crowded and overgrown that the decision was made to rework those gardens as well. Lupe knows his plants. He know what will thrive on the island and what will not. Thank you also to Francis and Island Irrigation for their great work and help with this project. They too have offered us nothing but the best. Finally, we will also be updating the gardens at the Beach Haven Church. When we sold the old St. Thomas Church my only request was that we keep the copper crosses on the top of the building. The next project will be to create a garden memorial to the faithful people who built and prayed in the original St. Thomas Church for over half a century. 

An Invitation to Contemplative Living



We will be hosting our 51st anniversary 18 Mile Race this year! Since 1973, the 18 Mile Run has been contested in honor of the 11 Israeli Olympic athletes and coaches murdered during the Munich Games of 1972 and, in recent years, of those lost in the Sept. 11, 2001 terrorist attacks – the mile markers bear the names of those Israeli athletes and coaches, as well as the names of the three Island residents who died on 9/11.


