#### **ADVENTure and a Few Words of Thanks!**

With the First Week of Advent, we begin a new liturgical year. There is something refreshing about starting over. We do have a tendence to continue to do the same thing over and over again, so shaking it up a bit isn't bad. Don't get me wrong, consistency is good. It can ground us and give us a sense of identity, security, and direction. I know when I go to Costco I try to park in the same spot. It makes life so

much easier when I leave the store because I can remember where I parked! Have you ever wandered through a parking lot not remembering where you left your car? It's not good!

But unlike the three kings, we don't need to wander anymore since we have found the Christ, the Light of the world, the Prince of Peace, the Wonder Counselor. 

Are you interested in a deeper relationship with God? Do you experience a desire to pray always? Are you searching for a better understanding of the actions of God's grace in your life?

Spiritual Direction is not about problem solving. It is neither counseling nor therapy. It is about enhancing one's prayer life. Directors help people recognize and respond to God's will in their life experiences. One Director summed up the process this way, "All I do is listen. People already have a spiritual life; they are not starting here. Often they need relief from the pressure that they are not doing the right thing. I help them see the goodness in where they are on their journey, not where they think they're supposed to be." God is the real spiritual director.

The Diocese of Trenton has several training programs called an internship. These are two or three year programs focusing on deepening one's own spiritual life and on learning the dynamics of Spiritual Direction. Upon completion of the program a person receives a Certificate from the Diocese.

Our parish has four certified Spiritual Directors.



#### Did You Know??

Beginning with the 2023 filing season, the law increases the income limit for the Property Tax Freeze to \$150,000 (that's a \$50,000 increase from 2022); and eliminates the requirement that an applicant must be a New Jersey resident for 10 consecutive years. The age/disability and three-year homeownership requirements remain unchanged. Starting in February of 2023 the PTR Books (aka the Blue Books) will start being mailed out. If 2023 will be your first year eligible to file, please call or come into St. Francis Senior Services for the application. There is also still time to file for your ANCHOR rebate until December 31st. Senior Services will assist in filing any of these applications with you. 
