## Sunday, March 10, 2024 Light of Hope in the Darkness

Today's readings: 2 Chronicles 36:14–16, 19–23; Psalm 137: 1–2, 3, 4–5, 6; Ephesians 2:4–10; John 3:14–21. Hope and joy are recurring themes in the readings and prayers on the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Midway through Lent, just as we begin to weary in our resolve, the readings remind us of God's love and the eternal life that awaits, and the prayers relate the Christian response of joy. The entrance antiphon begins, "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her," recalling for us that Lent is also a season for joy. The liturgical color varies from the season's violet to rose today to visually encourage us. This day points to the reconciliation that

is ours because of Christ's death and resurrection. And we have merited none of this. Only by the mercy of God do we live in Christ. As the reading from Ephesians states, "It is the gift of God; it is not from works so no one may boast." Some accept the gift of faith, but as the Gospel states, "The light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light." At baptism, we received the light of Christ and, with that light, join Christ in dispelling darkness. This week, be aware that you carry the light of Christ within you and can bring others to it.



Tuition fees are \$130.00 for 1 child. \$160.00 for 2 children, \$190.00 for 3 or more children. Fees are not required at the time of registration.

Classes are attended by the child and a family member once a month September to May.

Children receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation (Grade 5), First Eucharist (Grade 2) or Confirmation (Grade 8) require 2 consecutive years of Formation.

## **Spiritual Direction**

The "Direction" part of the term Spiritual Direction can be off-putting, even for us as directors. This process is not about one person telling the other what to do - "directing" them. Spiritual companionship or soul-friending might be a better term. 'Spiritual Direction" has stuck for some reason,

but as Thomas Keating advises: "It is not so much being told what to do as being encouraged to do what we know God and our conscience are asking us to do." A spiritual director has been trained to listen to the person they are with in collaboration with the Holy Spirit. Thus, one often sees a picture of three chairs to symbolize the process, one for the director, one for the seeker and one for the Spirit! Protecting God's Children® for Adults is training conducted by VIRTUS® certified facilitators on the prevention of child sexual abuse. All employees must also be recertified and have follow up background checks every four years. The Human Resources Director and Director of Religious Education participate in an annual audit with the Diocese of Trenton to ensure we are in compliance.
