

A Letter From The Pastor...





Six Friars!?

Believe it or not it was a year ago [just about] that I became the pastor of St. Francis Parish. Because of the pandemic, 2020 was a year like none other so the proper transfer from Fr. Jim to me was really just a date that we both agreed would work. September 14, 2020 arrived; he was out and I was in. Done. Works for me.

People will often ask me how am I doing, or how is the parish doing, and my response is always the same, "I'm on Long Beach Island, it doesn't get much better than this!" That is the truth! The island is wonderful but being at St. Francis Parish is also such a great blessing for me, as I know it is also for the other friars, Sr. Pat, and everyone else on the Pastoral Staff. We have all the issues that every other parish has but I'm not sure if they have the dedicated parishioners like we do. We are blessed!!

One question people really haven't asked, but I think might be on your minds, is, "How is it that we have 6 priests?" I don't know of any other parish that has 6 priests. Most have one and many pastors are responsible for two churches, like Msgr. Ken Tuzeneu at St. Mary's, Barnegat, and St. Mary's of the Pines, Manahawkin. When I commented to him about that, he said, "You have four!" To which I said, "But that's different." We both smiled.

Yes, we are blessed to have 6 friar priests but that really is a unique product of circumstances. The friars belong to Holy Name Province which is headquartered in New York City. We have been working with 5 of the 6 other provinces in the US so to eventually becoming one province. It looks like that realignment will take place in 2023. In preparation for that, the 6 provinces each evaluated their respective ministries to determine where we can remain and where we cannot. In January 2020, after our province's evaluations were finished, our Provincial, Fr. Kevin Mullen, OFM, and the Provincial Council, decided that we needed to withdraw from 10 of our 30 ministry sites. We sadly left some parishes, some college campuses, and some other ministries that we thought we just could not faithfully serve with the amount of friars we have and the amount of friars that we are projected to have in the near future.

It was really that realignment within Holy Name Province that has allowed us to have 6 friar-priests here on Long Beach Island. Because we are Franciscans, our common life is our first call and from that flows our ministry. We hold up the virtue of living together so we do seek ways to support and enhance our common life. One way we do that is having "Senior Friars in Residence." This allows a friar to retire but also be as active as they want to be. Fr. Andrew Reitz and Fr. John Frambes are "Senior Friars in Residence." I am grateful that both of them want to be here and put in full days ministering in our parish and beyond. As retired friars they are financially supported by our Province. Fr. Scott, Fr. Steve, Fr. Kevin and I are full-time employees of the parish but it is the six of us that make up our fraternity.

I do have to augment my positive acclamation about living on Long Beach Island to also include that I get to live with some wonderful men who proclaim the Gospel from the pulpit, but also with their lives. Of course, I love it here!

Weekly Reflections...

When was the last time you rode the train? Some time ago, a New York paper published a picture of two subway riders. One man, an Orthodox Jew wearing a yarmulke, sat quietly while a young African American with a hoodie slept peacefully on his shoulder. The picture caused quite a sensation. It was an unlikely duo: the yarmulke and the hoodie joined to each other. With so much fear and suspicion, it was up lifting to see this unlikely pair connected. One New Yorker just wanted

to offer another New Yorker a little help! It offers us hope. Sometimes it is as simple as offering hope! It's a little bit like in today's gospel; Peter and Jesus: an unlikely duo! Peter had a certain image or expectation of what "the Christ" was to be or to do. Suffering and death had nothing to do with Peter's "Christ". But they had everything to do with "God's Christ". God thinks and acts in terms of love and life and salvation. Jesus asks us the same question that he asked Peter. "Who do you say that I am?" At Baptism, we were united in Christ. We were given our identity as children of God and our mission to be disciples of Christ. This is a life-long process of God's work in us. We respond as disciples by following in the footprints of Christ. It is our daily living that shows the answer to this question. It is in our prayer that we come to know God's love and mercy for us. When we are compassionate, loving and forgiving of each other, we are the "hands and feet and shoulders" of Christ for one another. It is in becoming Christ-like that we too become "an unlikely duo: Jesus and us together". We are called to be followers who give of ourselves for the good of others. Sometimes it is as simple as offering hope!

May the Lord strengthen all of us to live the hope and joy that the gospel offers us this week!



"October 4 is the day the Church sets aside to celebrate St. Francis of Assisi's *dies natalis*—his birth into eternal life. Francis is easily one of the Church's most beloved and venerated saints. Thus, even the *vigil* of his death is celebrated in style. October 3 is the vigil of his passing over and bears a special name - his *Transitus*. The word is derived from the Latin meaning "passage," "crossing" or "going over." The feast has always been an important part of Franciscan spirituality. Ideally, a Christian shouldn't be afraid of death - or as Francis called it, "Sister Death." Francis faced his own end with what could be described as joyful aplomb. A gentle turning to God in the final, ultimate mystery - the passing over or, the *turning* over, of one's soul to its Lover and Author."
