

Happy Easter!

Sometimes, when I'm not distracted, or the TV is not too loud in my room at the friary, I can hear the calming, rhythmic crashing of the ocean waves, and I love it. I find comfort in those sounds of nature drifting up from the shore, even making their way through the closed windows. As we know, those waves are always coming to the shore whether we are aware of them or not. They are constant and consistent, storms notwithstanding. To me, they are a great reminder of God's grace, and with that, God's love and mercy, and God's presence. We may be distracted by the many things going on in our lives or the "closed windows" may get in the way of hearing God, or knowing that God is near, but rest assure, just like those waves, God is constant and consistent. God is with us.

In our celebration of the Pascal Mystery of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, we find out a bit more of who God really is. We may not know a lot about God but we do know this, God raised Jesus from the dead. We also know that Jesus prayed to God, "Let this cup pass from me," and he cried out from the cross, "Why have you abandoned me?" – perhaps we may have even felt or thought the same - but we also know that God didn't. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

Weekly Reflections...

On behalf of all the sisters and friars and staff of St Francis Parish, we offer you a very Happy and Healthy Easter. I hope you have followed the other liturgies this week, Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday and the Easter Vigil. For all of Lent we have been preparing for Easter. The celebration of Jesus' Resurrection! And I suppose anticipating in the future our own resurrection and the resurrection of our friends and family.

One theological word that comes to mind in this regard is salvation. One translation of the word is "coming home". Jesus coming home to the Father and the Holy Spirit in the kingdom of Heaven. And in the future our coming home to heaven also.

On the Easter Vigil we have several symbols. We start with the Easter Fire. There are two meaning of the fire that we celebrate, the Divine Presence and Jesus' Resurrection. Flame has been a sign of the Divine Presence in the scriptures in particular Moses at the "burning bush" and "tongues of fire" over the heads of the believers at Pentecost. Additionally at baptism we are told receive the "light of Christ". In John's gospel Light is an important image. Jesus sharing that He is the "Light to the world". I am told light represents: wisdom, leadership and inspiration.

The Second symbol would be water. To have water is to have life. As space craft travel to study the Planet Mars, researchers have looking for evident of life on the barren surface and if there is evidence of water long ago. From a sacramental belief water is the beginning of our spiritual life and a relationship with God in our baptisms.

The next sign are the three oils which are blessed by the Bishop very year during Lent at the Chrism Mass. They are first Sacred Chrism for Baptism and Holy Orders and other various blessings. In are baptisms we are called children of the light and children of God. The Second is the Oil of the Catechumate, used to bless the candidates preparing for baptism and lastly Oil of the infirmed to pray for members of the community needing healing.

One item I am fond of is the incense. But some people in our community have a negative reaction to incense. It is an attempt to please God in the Heavens.

In my youth I remember the importance of Easter for our family. My sisters were dressed with their Easter outfits and with Easter Bonnets with long ribbons. Years ago during the blessing of the Easter Water, my father being the grand knight was helping at the time of the blessing a moth dove into the water. My father discretely saved the moth and sent it on is way.

Lastly this year we have reinstated the Sunrise Mass on the Beach. Fr. Andrew celebrated the very first Sunrise Mass 51 years ago. It is a very popular event.

Again Happy and Healthy Easter to all.

In preparation for Easter, grades one through four will have an opportunity to experience the events of the week before and after Easter. Children will be using the Easter Story Eggs to tell the story of the Resurrection. In addition, they will be introduced to the Pascal candle by making a representational candle using styrofoam, a sharpie, tissue paper and cloves for the nails at Jesus' feet and hands. Grade five received their First Reconciliation with many family members participating in the Sacrament as well.

Grade six will conclude their formal classes with instruction — The Messianic Fulfillment. Discussion will include the Gospel writers' meaning of "disciple", why the twelve were chosen, why Jesus had to die and the Emmaus story. The Encounter book will concentrate on God's plan and the important part each person has in His plan for salvation. He has a mission that only you can carry out. The Saint of the week is Elizabeth of the Trinity.

Grade seven will have a retreat as their last class. It will begin with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The theme is "Filling Your Spiritual Tool Box". There will be special break-out sessions offering ideas on how the pre-Confirmation candidates can prepare as they move on to the last phase of Confirmation preparation in the Fall.

Confirmation for the 2022 candidates will be on **April 29th** at 4:00 pm. The presider will be Bishop O'Connell.

First Eucharist will be celebrated on May 7th and 8th and again May 15th.

Family Faith will close the year on May 19th will a prayer service and the crowning of the Blessed Mother.




