

### Weekly Reflections...

#### Saints of God, the Lord be with you!

I don't know about vou but I have been rejected. I was always the last one (grudgingly) picked for team sports, there were times when I didn't get the job, when overtures of friendship or leadership were neither wanted nor understood. Rejection is painful since it breaks the heart and the spirit.

In the readings this weekend, Saint Peter reminds his listeners of Psalm 118, "The stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone." (Acts of the Apostles 4: 8-12). Jesus, rejected and crucified by humanity, is accepted and risen from the dead by God. And this should give us all hope and solace. There is someone who will never reject us.... God. In fact, God's love for us is so complete that we are called, "children of God" here in this earthly life. But wait, there's more! In the second reading St. John writes, "we are God's children now; what we shall be has not been revealed...we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is." (1 John 3: 1-2).

So if you've ever been rejected, ask yourself has that experience made you bitter or better. And the movement from bitter to better is a process: much like the Emmaus story found in the Gospel according to Saint Luke (24: 13-35). If being rejected has made you bitter and you seem stuck, ask Christ to heal your heart and your spirit. It might also be a blessing to seek out some short term counselling. If being rejected has made you a better person, ask the Lord to show you how you can be supportive to someone who the church or society rejects.






