

<u>Marriage</u>: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

A Letter From The Pastor...



Christ is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen! Christos voskrese! Voistinu voskrese!

Years ago, a priest friend of mine, Fr. Bill, with faculties in the *Latin Rite* [ours] and in the *Ruthenian Greek Catholic Rite*, taught me the Easter Acclamation in Old Church Slavonic: "*Christos voskrese!*" to which one would respond, "*Voistinu voskrese!*" "Christ is Risen!" "Indeed, He is Risen!" It was the custom to greet others with this exchange during the Easter Season.

Sadly, that custom never lasted within the Latin Rite cultures. It certainly would change the way we live out the Easter Season, from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday. My intuition tells me that the Eastern Churches were able to capture the importance of what Easter is for those who believe.

Have you ever gotten to the point where life doesn't make sense, [hello 2020, +] or have you ever asked that proverbial question, "Why do bad things happen to good people?" If so, all we must do is look to today's celebration. Easter may not answer our questions, but it does offer us a new way to look at life and everything within it. As Christians, we would say that it is the *only* way to look at life and all that is within it. Jesus was crucified for political and religious reasons. It is one of the most inhuman ways to die. In Jesus' time, they believed that one who was "hung on a tree" was cursed by God. [Deuteronomy 21:22] So not only did Jesus have to endure a horrific execution they also made sure that even God would curse him.

Yet, despite the agony in Gethsemane, the painful crown, the lashes with a barbaric whip, and the humiliation of a crucifixion, God did not curse him. Rather, Easter shows us that God's power was mightier, is mightier, than anything evil or bad that befalls us.

Easter is not just a celebration of Spring with daffodils and tulips, but it is THE celebration that gives meaning to our lives and defines who we are.

For Christians, Easter is the only optic through which we see the world, our politics, our religion, and our lives.

On behalf of the friars, Sr. Pat, and the entire Pastoral Staff, we want to wish you a very Happy Easter. We pray that the hope that comes forth from this Feast of Feasts is always yours.

During this Easter season, we pray that God's powerful grace transform our pains and sorrows, our fears, our struggles and failures, our mourning, and our dying, into that which is life itself!
