A Letter From The Pastor...

#### Oh Henri!

Last weekend was a mess! Henri's rains arrived Saturday night and we woke up to find that a great part of the boulevard was underwater. Beach Haven was fine but a good part of the boulevard in Long Beach Township, Ship Bottom, and Surf City was underwater. Some of the Masses had to be cancelled because I did not think it was safe for people [including the friars] to have to drive through these high waters. Just another blessing of living a few feet above sea level!

In last weekend's bulletin, for those who missed it, I thanked a wide range of people who helped create this year's Festival of the Sea. I've heard it said so many times, as I am sure you have as well, one problem when thanking people by name is that it is so easy to miss someone. I didn't miss someone. I missed an entire group - the Festival of the Sea Youth Team and their coordinators, Marion, Kait, and Cathy. We had over 45 teenage volunteers who helped make our Festival happen! Some worked at the games, some mixing and serving icetea, lemonade, or cold water to our festival volunteers, some worked in the parking lot, some got dunked in the dunking booth, or some did food runs for the grill and food court. My sincere apologies to all of you for not including you in our lineup last week since you contributed just as much as everyone else to make Festival 2021 such a great success. Thank you for your energy and enthusiasm, your graciousness and your kindness, and your desire to help our parish and our festival.

*Back to Henri!* In February I shared information about signing up for the "*Rainedout*" app that will contact you either via email or text if and when the Parish and Center is closed, including when Masses are cancelled. After this past weekend's flooding and cancellations I thought perhaps it would be good to share it with you again.

When we close the Parish & Center it is usually because the boulevard is, or is predicted to be, impassable and dangerous. Please note that if the Parish and Center is closed during the week the 9:00 AM Mass will also be cancelled.

Here are the simple steps to sign up to receive this important information.

- 1. On your computer or mobile device go to rainedout.com
- 2. Click on the yellow box "Receive Messages."
- 3. Next, in the dialogue box, above the word "Search," type in **LBICC**. St. Francis Center, LBICC Inc. will appear below.
- 4. Click on **St. Francis Center, LBICC** [highlighted in blue].
- 5. Click, **Continue**. [Do not worry about the fee. The emails are free. The Parish & Center will pick up the cost if you choose to receive texts.]
- 6. Click the box "Agree to Terms of Service."
- 7. Add your email address and or your phone number in the appropriate box and click "**Start Signup**."

*Rainedout* will send a validation code to your phone or email address. To confirm the set up you will need to type that code in the dialogue box on the website page. Done! Simple, no?



# World Day of Prayer



We invite all to join us on Wednesday, September 1 at the 9:00 AM Mass in Brant Beach for a special liturgy celebrating the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation.

The letter establishing this Day of Prayer was sent by Pope Francis to Peter Turkson, a Ghanaian Cardinal of the Catholic Church who spoke at the St. Louis Climate Summit in 2018 on the ecology of the world, and Cardinal Kurt Koch from Switzerland. Below is an excerpt from this letter:

"...for believers in Jesus Christ, the Word of God who became man for our sake, "the life of the spirit is not dissociated from the body or from nature or from worldly realities, but lived in and with them, in communion with all that surrounds us" (Laudato Si' 216). The ecological crisis thus summons us to a profound spiritual conversion: Christians are called to "an ecological conversion whereby the effects of their encounter with Jesus Christ become evident in their relationship with the world around them" (ibid., 217). For "living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience" (ibid.).

Our patron saint, Francis of Assisi, is the patron saint of animals and ecology, and the original advocate for the earth. Pope Francis, by taking the name of the saint of ecology, stresses "the interrelationship between how we treat the planet and how we treat one another." May we become champions for our environment and caring protectors of all humanity.




