

Christmas 2021 Giving Fund

Dear Fellow Parishioner and Friends of St. Francis Parish and Center,

Last year I wrote to you explaining the financial situation of the parish and center and your response was tremendous. We collected \$317,000 because of your great generosity!

Wow! You surpassed every expectation I had ever imagined.

Between your response, some cutbacks, and careful management by our directors, the parish ended the fiscal year with a surplus of \$198,699.21. That was great news!

People are coming back to Mass but still not like it was before Covid. Our Sunday collections continue to struggle to meet our budgeted needs. We are in a different situation than we were last year at this time but we are still in need of your help to meet our expenses in this fiscal year.

As of last Sunday, Nov. 28th, our Sunday collections were \$178,127.83 behind our budget schedule. Last year's surplus is almost gone.

The parish finance council and I have been working on ways to build a financially sustainable future for our parish but at this point I do need to reach out to you once again to ask for your help.

Any contribution you can make to our *Christmas 2021 Giving Fund* is most appreciated. You will see the form outlining the different levels of support in today's bulletin.

If you wish to make a contribution in memory of someone who is deceased, or in honor of someone who is living, their names, along with yours, will be enrolled in our *Christmas 2021 Perfect Light Society*. The names of those enrolled will be listed in our bulletin and our online social media outlets and you and your intentions will be remembered at all of our Christmas Masses.

Please be assured of my prayers and gratitude, along with those of the other friars, Fr. Andrew, Fr. John, Fr. Kevin, Fr. Steve, and Fr. Scott, as well as Sr. Pat, and all of our parish and center staff.

I again thank you for your generous response last year and kindly ask you to consider contributing to this year's *Christmas 2021 Giving Fund*. Thank you for your support and your belief in the mission of St. Francis Parish and Center.

May God continue to bless you with peace and all that is good.



A Letter From The Pastor...





For God has commanded that every lofty mountain be made low,

and that the age-old depths and gorges be filled to level ground,

that Israel may advance secure in the glory of God...

for God is leading Israel in joy by the light of his glory,

with his mercy and justice for company. Bar. 5: 7,9

Just when we thought the light was getting brighter "omicron" seems to be ready to knock on our door! Yet another variant of the Covid virus is making its way around the world. Of course, the news media picks it up, as they should, since we are better off knowing about it than not knowing about it. The head in the sand strategy rarely works. But if your thoughts were anything like mine when you first heard the story, you too asked, "When will it end?"

The truth of the matter is we just don't know when it will end, Covid, that is. It is seemingly becoming our "new normal" ... at least for now. If Covid has taught us anything, it is that there is still a lot that we don't know.

There is, however, a lot that we do know. We know we are tired of living in the shadow of fear and the pain of isolation. We know that we want it to be over so we can get rid of these blessed masks forever. We also know that the science behind how best to contain the spread of the virus is pretty accurate: wash your hands [a lot,] wear masks, avoid touching your face, maintain social distancing, stay home if you are not feeling well, and get vaccinated. That has definitely slowed the spread of the virus but yet we also know that it doesn't stop it completely.

Apart from "omicron" there has been a steady uptick of infections and hospitalization in our area and around the country. Unfortunately, this is not the time to let our guard down. As the weather gets colder and we spend more time inside I'm sure this trend will continue. Remembering the Church's long standing tradition of pursuing of the common good, I would strongly suggest that when gathering for Mass please try to be as socially distant as possible and wear a mask for your own protection as well as those around you.

These December days are the darkest of our year – literally. The shortest light hours in one day, Dec. 20, is 9 hours 22 minutes, compared to the longest light hours in one day, June 21, is 14 hours 59 minutes. But I think Covid, and everything else going on in our world, has put us all into a deeper darkness.

Hopefully, today's readings offer us some inspiration. The Book of Baruch, as well as today's Gospel passage from Luke, tell us that the painful depths of our life will be filled, the winding and difficult road that we are on will be made straight, and God is leading us by the light of his glory, even in our darkness.

The God we believe in shared that good news thousands of years ago and shares it with us today. Although we may be in the dark – physically, mentally, and perhaps even spiritually – be assured that you are not alone. We are not alone. God is with us, and, hopefully you know in your heart of hearts that in our parish community, we are there for one another too.

No one said Advent waiting would be easy. I think this year we know that better than most. Let's hold on tight, pray hard, and reach out to one another in support – wearing a mask of course – so to live the hope of this Advent season. The hope that comes from God alone.



Weekly Reflections...



Currently the Big Bang theory is the most popular way to explain the beginning of the Universe according to science. It also compliments a religious understanding of Creation: at one moment God said, Let there be.... And then it was. First there was nothing and then at the word of God, it all began. It was an explosion of divine creativity.

Science deals with the material universe, matter and energy. I also imagine a Big Bang of spiritual creation. It coincides with the beginning of the material universe, permeates it and drives it, expanding creation to completion.

In the Creed we profess that God is the maker of all things visible and invisible. The invisible is more than the dark matter of astrophysicists, but is spirit that permeates and animates all of creation.



MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT:

St. Francis Senior Services staff are trained State Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors for assistance in Medicare A, B, C or D information. Do you know the difference? Medicare A primarily pays for a stay in the hospital, or a skilled nursing facility, B is for doctor's services and outpatient services such as lab tests, C pays for the Medicare Advantage or managed care alternative to traditional Medicare and D of course is the prescription drug plan.

Soon Medicare beneficiaries will once again need to make a decision about their prescription drug coverage. Medicare Part D open enrollment period **runs through December 7th.** During this time, people with Medicare can sign up for a prescription drug plan or switch their current Medicare Part D plan in order to have the best coverage beginning January of 2020. And yes, it's best to check each year for changes. Open enrollment is also the perfect time to review your Medicare Advantage plan with a SHIP Counselor to be notified of any changes. What if you cannot afford a Medicare Part D plan? There is federal assistance available for people with Medicare who have limited income and resources. 
