

### Happy Sunday Good People!

Thank you for welcoming John McCrone last weekend. I think the Fix-It Program is a win-win for everyone. He was very impressed by our parish and your response. In his thank you note to me he wrote, "I've received 3 calls from potential volunteers and one call for assistance. The ratio at your parish is upside down compared to the other parishes where I

have made appeals. We normally would get I volunteer and three calls for assistance. You have a wonderful congregation that want to help those in need. Based on my experience in doing this, they are unique. Bravo, and thank you and your parishioners." I don't know about you, but I'm not surprised. You are a wonderful congregation and we do have a great community! Bravo to you!

Continuing with those kudos, in last week's bulletin I said I would share the details of the *Christmas 2021 Giving Fund*. Once again, you showed your true colors!

Your generous response to the Christmas 2021 Giving Fund [2021 CGF] totaled, \$244,950. To our parishioners and to all the friends of St. Francis Parish who contributed to this year's 2021 CGF THANK YOU!! Your generous spirit is truly amazing, but wait. It gets better!

You may recall when I gave the report last year I had a question about how the 2020 CGF might affect the actual Christmas collection. As already shared, last year's Christmas collection was \$86,007. That was \$132 shy of the year before. So no, the additional collection really did not affect the Christmas collection. A fun piece to note about that, one parishioner, after reading the bulletin, sent me a check for \$132 to make up the difference. Isn't that something? The goodness of people.

Of course, that question was there again this year, but knowing you, I wasn't too concerned. And I didn't have to be! This year our Christmas collection was \$105,101. *Wowie – as Sr. Kate used to say*! That is the largest Christmas collection we've had in a very long time, if not ever! Thank you, Thank you!

You have probably noticed in the weekly bulletin that our weekly collections continue to fall short of what we budget to collect on a given weekend, but your generosity with the 2021 CGF and the Christmas collection absolutely helped us move in the right direction. I recently met with Stacey Kelsall, our comptroller, for a mid-year budget review. We are both much more confident after these two collection. We may still not end up in the black by the end of the fiscal year [having a blizzard on a Saturday night didn't help!] but we are definitely much closer to a zero balance than the November predictions. I will keep you posted as we move forward, but I cannot thank you enough for your continued generosity of your time and your donations to our great parish. We are a great parish. Thank you for helping to make it so!

May God continue to bless you and your families. You are a blessing to St. Francis Parish and the world.



### We remember the Baltimore Catechism

The Catechism is usually seen as this textbook of questions and answers about the faith. Many years ago, as preparation for Confirmation, it was to be memorized in case the Bishop asked any of these questions of the candidates.

A little background information:

ms. undirectaylors, accounted in the early church prior to the advent of the printing press, Catholic teaching would be an oral experience.

In the 1500's information was able to be fixed in print and the Church adopted this approach.

In 1884 the Third Plenary Council of Baltimore decided to publish a national catechism containing 421 questions and answers in 37 chapters. The "Baltimore Catechism" gave unity to teaching and understanding the faith. Its impact was felt right up to 1962 and the Second Vatican Council. In 1985, The American Bishops expressed the need for a universal catechism, the outcome being the Catechism of the Catholic Church (*Print 1992*). A new edition, which contained some modifications, was released in 1997.

Recently there was an interesting article in *Our Sunday Visitor* about a new visionary approach to understanding the Catechism. Three young Catholics embarked on a mission to inject life into the catechism through a new digital initiative that came to be called Real+True. Through their eyes they saw that the heart of the Catechism is Jesus. Their focus is to speak directly to people on-line. Through the videos, they hope to spark interest in emphasizing fundamental human questions and encounters with Christ.

This project is a four year understanding with completion of Part 1 in 2022.

Maybe this Catechism project has piqued your interest. Well, don't let that interest fade. Here are a few ways to dive right into the new content that is constantly being created by Real+True.

When our in-person parent/child classes resume in February, our classes from grades one to five will be discussing different sacraments. For grade one they will experience a re-enactment of Baptism initiated by our Pastor with a follow up activity. Grade two will talk about the Last Supper, do an art project and watch a video in preparation for First Communion. Grade three is talking about all sacraments and creating a sacrament game. Grade four is talking about Reconciliation and forgiveness. They will be using an activity pamphlet to learn more about the Sacrament. Grade five is preparing for Reconciliation with an examination of conscience activity. There are examples for discussion and a prayer service.

All classes begin at 5:30 PM with temperatures taken and masks worn by all, parents, children and catechists.

6<sup>th</sup> grade students/parents Bible study will resume with session 4 of the Ascension Press "Encounter" program videos on the Old Testament: Desert Wanderings and Conquest and Judges. Student/parent teams will be using their Bibles for a Bible search as well as looking up the upcoming Sunday Gospel. The Saint lesson is about St. Helena, there is a QR code which contains a very informative video/movie on St. Helena. The Theme for this class is Celebrating Mass with a puzzle activity. There will be handouts and worksheets for more at home study of the Mass.

Our seventh grade families will discuss the question, "If you decided to commit your whole life to doing good what would you do?" Through scripture reading this question will be explored in light of the teachings of Jesus. Continuing with the preparation process for Confirmation the candidates will discover that the Apostles began the Church's public ministry at Pentecost, ritual actions of the Sacrament, ways in which Baptism and Eucharist are connected to Confirmation. The saint lesson will be on Venerable Mother Henriette DeLille. Closing prayer will be the Daily Examen.

Our Confirmation candidates will gather on January 31 for their

workshop on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Our Pastor Fr. Fran will speak on the ways in which ritual actions in the Sacrament


