Letter from the Pastor Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 27, 2022

Summer, already? Not quite yet!

The other day in the friary Fr. Kevin said, "Isn't it great, it's still light outside at ten to 6!" To which Fr. Steve said, "Yes, but that only means the traffic lights will be turned on soon." Although we are at the end of February, Steven is right. Those lights will be turned on in just a few months. In most parishes the summer is the time to slow down while the "academic year," September through May, is their busy times. One might think that because our summers are out of the park busy, crazy, and wonderful, the "academic year" would be our slow time. Relatively speaking it is but St. Francis Parish turns into a "normal" parish during the months of September – May and we are just as busy as all those other parishes. Like the seasons in Florida, hot and hotter, the tempo of our parish is busy and busier. But honestly, that is one of the things I like about our parish. There is always something going on.

The Men's Cornerstone Retreat will be March 11 – 12. The sign-up sheets are in the foyer of the church. I have heard so much about this retreat, and how powerful it is, I decided to go. If you have any inklings of participating, perhaps that's God's way of saying, "Do it!" For the women of our parish, yours will be in the Fall. For those looking for more of a one on one support in your spiritual journey our parish has four wonderful spiritual directors. They have all been trained in the art of spiritual direction and are ready to welcome you to a conversation to talk about your own spiritual journey. When going through the bulletin you will find that there are many different opportunities in how can engage your spiritual life, be it through the Book Club, Men's Spirituality Group, Scripture Study, Survivors of Suicide, or the Secular Franciscan Community, based here in our Parish.

There are two upcoming events that I would like to bring to your attention. The first is the *Spiritual Conversations* that will be taking place during the month of March. A few weeks ago I shared with you that Pope Francis hopes to hear from every baptized Catholic in preparation for the Synod in 2023. Jen and Anthony Mauro, the co-chairs of the Synod 2023 Steering Committee, also have a letter to the parish in this week's bulletin. They explain a bit about the process as well as the times when you can participate in one of these conversation. I do hope that you can add your voice to not only this parish-wide listening session, but this world-wide listening session.

The other exciting news that I would like to share with you is that this year St. Francis Center is celebrating 50 years, 1972 - 2022! I am sure that there are many people who remember when it was built. They would be the same people who remember Fr. Andrew with long hair and mutton-chops. [Remember, it was the 70's] He probably wore bell-bottoms under his habit but we don't have any pictures to prove it! If you do have any pictures of Andrew and or the parish and center from years ago and would like to share them us, I would love to see them. You can scan them and send them to me or drop them off at the parish center.

To mark this anniversary, we do have a number of events planned. We will be hosting two 50th Anniversary Open Houses: May 1st from 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM; and July 10th also from 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM. We welcome you to come and explore the Center and learn about all the services that we offer. You may be surprised at all that goes on in the building behind the church! Swimming under the Stars on July 13 from 6:30 PM – 10:30 PM. Last year was the first year we held this event and it was a great success. It's a wonderful family event and the kids can even watch a movie as they swim. We will sponsor a Game Day Grab Raffle [the winner will be picked at the May 1st Open House] and a 50th Anniversary Dinner Dance on Saturday, August 27th. You can find more details on all of the Anniversary events in the Center's Spring Events pamphlets.

So yes, the traffic lights will be turned on soon and the summer will be here before we know it, but we have plenty of things going on now!

Weekly Reflections...

Saints of God, the Lord be with you.

Next week we begin the liturgical season of Lent: 40 days of preparation in order to celebrate the Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. During Lent, it is the custom of the Church to fast, pray, and give alms as a way to open ourselves to the upcoming feasts of Christ. As

I meditate on today's Gospel for the Eight Sunday in Ordinary time, [Luke 6:39-45] I find that I'm invited to fast from more than food.

In today's Gospel Jesus raises the question, "Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, [and let's not leave out the eyes of our sisters], but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?" I don't know about you, but for me at this point in my life, it's a habit. And often times it's fun and a great distraction from looking at, and naming, the wooden beam in my own eyes. I think Jesus is reminding us that we find what we look for. And instead of finding fault in others, we should begin to look for and name the good in others.

I've often said that my vocation as a priest is to highlight the everyday good that you do. So often when I do this, the response is usually some words of dismissal along the lines of "that's really nothing, Father." Well it is something...a very important something because the good we do is empowered by our God Who is the source of all good. The good we do is the Holy Spirit working within us and we cooperating with that same Spirit. My response to words of dismissal is usually, "Just say thank you." Thanksgiving is a great response to the fact that God in Christ chooses us to work and reveal himself in the world.

So as we prepare for Ash Wednesday and Lent, let's fast not just from food, but from judgement and condemnation. Let us feast on the goodness that flows through one another.

When our in-person parent/child classes resume in February, our classes from grades one to five will be discussing different sacraments. For grade one they will experience a re-enactment of Baptism initiated by our Pastor with a follow up activity. Grade two will talk about the Last Supper, do an art project and watch a video in preparation for First Communion. Grade three is talking about all sacraments and creating a sacrament game. Grade four is talking about Reconciliation and forgiveness. They will be using an activity pamphlet to learn more about the Sacrament. Grade five is preparing for Reconciliation with an examination of conscience activity. There are examples for discussion and a prayer service.

All classes begin at 5:30 PM with temperatures taken and masks worn by all, parents, children and catechists.

6th grade students/parents Bible study will resume with session 4 of the Ascension Press "Encounter" program videos on the Old Testament: Desert Wanderings and Conquest and Judges. Student/parent teams will be using their Bibles for a Bible search as well as looking up the upcoming Sunday Gospel. The Saint lesson is about St. Helena, there is a QR code which contains a very informative video/movie on St. Helena. The Theme for this class is Celebrating Mass with a puzzle activity. There will be handouts and worksheets for more at home study of the Mass

Our seventh grade families will discuss the question, "If you decided to commit your whole life to doing good what would you do?" Through scripture reading this question will be explored in light of the teachings of Jesus. Continuing with the preparation process for Confirmation the candidates will discover that the Apostles began the Church's public ministry at Pentecost, ritual actions of the Sacrament, ways in which Baptism and Eucharist are connected to Confirmation. The saint lesson will be on Venerable Mother Henriette DeLille. Closing prayer will be the Daily Examen.

Our Confirmation candidates will gather on January 31 for their

workshop on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Our Pastor Fr. Fran will speak on the ways in which ritual actions in the Sacrament

Please let us introduce ourselves – Jennifer and Anthony Mauro, co-chairs of the Synod steering committee. We are honored to have been asked to be part of the Synod of Bishops process, as St. Francis of Assisi Parish has been our spiritual home for more than 15 years.

As you may have heard, Pope Francis has called for a Synod of Bishops to meet in 2023. The overarching objective is for the Church to become a listening Church. For us to listen to each other about our faith journeys.

As part of this process, the Pope wants to hear from as many Catholics (both practicing and drifting) as possible. To that end, our parish is organizing a Spiritual Conversation Campaign. The goal of the campaign is to encourage all parishioners and all baptized Catholics to gather and offer their insights and to encounter one another in prayer and active listening. Questions will be asked, and a synopsis of each conversation will be recorded via notetaking and sent to the Diocese. All participant names will be kept in confidence, and no names will be included in the report. The Diocese will then condense and send this information on to the Vatican.

The questions are as follows:

- 1. What have been the joys and obstacles in your journeying together with the Church?
- 2. Consider the comments from the other participants in the first round. What resonated the most for you?
- 3. Reflecting on our conversation, how might the Holy Spirit be prompting you, and all of us as Church, to improve the ways we are able to journey together?

A group of parish volunteers have been trained as facilitators and notetakers. All parishioners and viewpoints will be welcomed and listened to. Open-mindedness and openheartedness will lead to prayerfulness and a reaffirming spirit within each listening session. We hope for a large number of participants. We also encourage each parishioner who plans on participating to extend an invitation to any family member, friend or acquaintance who may not be actively practicing our faith. It is important that we hear from them. Understand that we will not look to evangelize but will only provide non-judgmental listening. Our prayers will be offered to the Holy Spirit seeking guidance, discernment and support for all shared views, opinions, suggestions and hopes given by each and every active participant.

There will be two Spiritual Conversation Meetings, one held on Sunday, March 13, after the 10:00 AM Mass in the Parish Center and another on Saturday, March 26, at 10 AM in the Brant Beach Church Hall. There will also be a Zoom meeting at 7 PM, Monday, March 7. To sign up for one of these meetings, or for more information, email synod.stfrancis@gmail.com.

We pray now that the Holy Spirit will help you make the decision to participate and we extend our gratefulness in advance for you doing so.
