

A Letter From The Pastor...



Second Sunday, Ordinary Time

The Christmas decorations are gone. The festivities are over. The run from Thanksgiving, through Christmas, into the New Year, is an exciting time but it is an exhausting time. There is so much going on and the expectations are so high. This year the stress was even higher than normal. I know many of us had to struggle with those expectations this year. Do we do what we always did, or do we celebrate only in our "bubble?" Then we had to figure out who's bubbles we trusted and who's we didn't.

Liturgically, we are now in "Ordinary" time – meaning ordered, referring to the sequence of the weeks ahead, 1st Week in Ordinary Time, 2nd Week, etc. In comparison to the past few months, we might interpret ordinary time to mean plan and simple ... well, ordinary. That might be so, but today's readings call us to anything but a plan, simple, ordinary time.

We hear the call of Samuel and then of Andrew who in turn goes and grabs his brother Peter. Not that ordinary! What I find interesting, however, is these extraordinary encounters with the Lord happen in the normal, ordinary, events of their day: a restless night's sleep – who hasn't had one of those?, or spotting something or someone that catches our eye while walking in the streets, supermarket, or driving on Rt. 72?

Perhaps it is when we are sleeping or just wondering about that the Lord calls us to "come and see." Perhaps it is in the mundane routine of our life that God's grace touches us and opens our eyes to see and our ears to hear. Perhaps it is in these times that we might be more available to hear Jesus' invitation to "come and see" and allow ourselves to "live with him."

Jesus' invitation calls us to enter into his world, where he lives, and find out who he is. Don't you get to know your friends a bit more when you go to their house and see how they live, where they live? How did they decorate the house, or not? Aren't we able to have a deeper conversation with others in the privacy of their home, or ours, than in Acme or Target?

Jesus invites us to meet him, not to rely on what other people say. He invites us personally to go deeper. Go beyond the superficial and what we have always known, so we can begin to understand the person who calls us to forgive 77 times, and why he calls us to forgive 77 times. What does he possess, that I don't, to have the desire to wash the feet of his followers or to have the ability to love his enemies?

I do love the holidays and decorations and music and all-around joy of the season but maybe, just maybe, with the distractions behind us, we can hear the Lord's invitation, in our ordinary, regular, repetitive days, to get to know who he is and who he is calling us to be.



During the months of October, November, and December, the **Food Pantry** typically sees an increase in the amount of families served. This year during the months of October and November, the pantry served **216**, **266** and **143 families respectively.**

In addition to assisting families with food, the **St. Francis Human Concerns Program** also holds three special projects on an annual basis; Back to School, Thanksgiving, and Gift of Warmth. This year we served 100 families for the Back to School project, **250** families for the Thanksgiving Project, and **208** families for the Gift of Warmth Project.
