Marriage: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

A Letter From The Pastoral Staff...



Saints of God, the Lord be with you!

Today the Church celebrates the Epiphany of the Lord in which three Gentile Kings or Magi seek out the newborn King of the Jews, adore Him, and give Him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh (Mt. 2: 1-12). What the evangelist is trying to do is to ease the tension of his mostly Jewish community to the reality that Christ came for people of all nations.

In his mystical writing *The Five Feasts of the Child Jesus*, the Franciscan Saint Bonaventure, writes that the question of the Magi, "Where is the newborn King of the Jews" is our question too. Where can we find Christ in this new year 2021? Bonaventure writes that we are to SEEK Christ present among us through our use of meditation, SEARCH for the Christ in our longings, and INQUIRE of the Child in our prayerful reflections. He goes on to write that we have all somehow and somewhere have seen His splendor. I would suggest that most often this splendor is swaddled in humility. We have seen Christ's splendor in listening to His word found in Scripture. We have tasted His splendor in the Eucharistic bread and wine. But as this feast reminds us, Christ's splendor wraps the earth: we can experience Christ when we go down to the ocean or the bay, when we look up at the stars and planets, when we meditate and give thanks for our own lives. We experience Christ revealing Himself through the love of a spouse or a friend, or dare I say it even a pet. Like the magi, we are called to find the Christ not necessarily in the usual places, but also in the unexpected ones.

While there is much to be afraid of in this world, and while the events of this upcoming year remain unknown, there is much for which to be grateful. We have found and experienced Christ. And even more wonderful is the fact that Christ has found and remains with us...no matter what.
