Mary, Mother of God

Mary kept all these things,

Today's Gospel begins with the Shepherds recounting their story to Joseph and Mary after they found "the infant laying in the manger" and Mary held all that she heard in her heart. We can only imagine what was going in on her

May the world soon know the peace of God's kingdom, and may we help to make it so.

Marriage: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.



Did You Know??

In addition to assisting families with food, the **St. Francis Human Concerns Program** also holds three special projects on an annual basis; Back to School, Thanksgiving, and Gift of Warmth. This year our projects served 86 families who enrolled and 50 extra backpacks that were given to the Lacey School District reaching a total of 254 children for the Back to School project, 215 families reaching 553 adults and 307 children for the Thanksgiving Project, and 208 families reaching 536 children for the Gift of Warmth Project.
