# Synod and Synodality

Synod is a word we don't hear very often. Although it has deep roots in our Catholic tradition the idea of synod faded over the centuries. It was reestablished by Pope Paul VI in September of 1965 in his letter, *Apostolica Sollicitudo*, (Apostolic Concern,) a few months before the solemn ending of the Second Vatican Council on Dec. 8 of the same year. Pope Paul began his letter calling for the renewal of the synodal practice within the Church. "The Apostolic concern leading Us to carefully survey the signs of the times and to make every effort to adapt the means and methods of the holy apostolate to the changing circumstances and need of our day, impels Us to establish even closer ties with the bishops in order to strengthen Our union with them "whom the Holy Spirit has placed [...] to rule the Church of God" (Acts 20:28). [AS 1]

Subsequently, his successors have called for a Synod of Bishops every three or four years to discuss important issues within the church. Occasionally, the popes have also called for "extraordinary" synods to consult on issues that required immediate attention. Pope Francis has called three extraordinary synods: on the family, on young people, and the most recent, the synod on the Amazon, held in Rome in October 2019 out of special concern for the peoples of the Amazon, whose lives and environment, he believes are under grave threat. It is obvious that Pope Francis likes the idea of synodality, that is, creating an opportunity to hear what people have to say about what is going on in their lives, in our world, and in our church. Although we are now well beyond the Christmas season we cannot forget the implication of the Incarnation is that God was, and is, found in our world and in our day. Synodality allows us to hear what other people are thinking. It does not change the truth that we have long held as a church but it might affect how we interpret that truth in our day.

The word synod, like many words in our church lexicon, have Greek roots. It is the merging of two Greek words, *syn*, which means "together with, jointly; at the same time," and *hodos*, "a way, path, road; a ride, journey. Pope Francis said in his address marking the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the institution of the Synod of Bishops, "What the Lord is asking of us is already in some sense present in the very word "Synod." Journeying together – laity, pastors, the Bishop of Rome – is an easy concept to put into words, but not so easy to put into practice." He went on to say, "It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium."

Pope Francis has said that he wants to hear from every baptized Catholic. I'm not sure if that is going to happen but each parish throughout the world has been asked to offer the opportunity for anyone who wishes to participate to do so. I have asked parishioners Jennifer and Anthony Mauro to co-chair our parish's effort to listen to as many of our faithful as possible. The entire process will focus on the question, "What have been the joys and obstacles in your journeying together with the church?

As I have said to Jen and Anthony, I realize that we have to send the feedback we receive from you to Trenton, who in turn will send a report to Rome, but I think the beauty of this process is that *we* get to hear, on the local level, about our joys and our struggles in our journey with the church. By entering in the process, we are doing exactly what synod is, we journey together. Please stay tuned for more details on how St. Francis Parish will participate in the preparation for the Synod of Bishops that will be held in 2023.


# Catholic Schools Week 2022 January 30 – February 5

# Weekly Reflections...



"I can't sing. My voice is horrible. If I did sing, I would be asked to be quiet." Yes, I have heard these comments from many people and while they may be true, what do these folk do when others are singing? Hopefully, listening, but I have a suggestion. The hymns in the hymnal are prayers and are chosen by Michele, the Director of Music, to go along with the theme that comes from the readings. Each

week, she takes time to figure what hymns fit the best with the readings. Some weeks it is easy and others, not so easy. But it takes time to do this.


My suggestion is for non-singers to pick up the hymnal and look at the hymn that others are singing. Remember, this is a prayer so pray it (to yourself) while others are singing. Let me give you an example: there is a hymn "We Walk by Faith." The verses are: We walk by faith and not by sight; no gracious words we hear from him who spoke as none'er spoke; but we believe him near. We may not touch his hands and side, nor follow where he trod; but in his promise we rejoice; and cry "My Lord and God." Help then, O Lord, our unbelief; and may our faith abound, to call on you when you are near, and seek where you are

Recognize these words? They are almost exactly words of the Gospel after Easter. There are many other examples. What an opportunity that is lost when someone thinks that they cannot participate because they can't sing. By following the text, you can make this your own prayer.

I have another suggestion. Before Mass while you are sitting in quiet prayer, take the hymnal and look at the hymns that will be used at Mass - they are listed on the hymn boards throughout the church. This will help you enter more consciously into the times during Mass that these hymns are sung.

I don't want anyone to feel left out because they can't sing. This is why I share these thoughts with you today. Hope they are helpful. Remember: pick up the hymnal and discover the treasury of prayers that are included.

When our in-person parent/child classes resume in February, our classes from grades one to five will be discussing different sacraments. For grade one they will experience a re-enactment of Baptism initiated by our Pastor with a follow up activity. Grade two will talk about the Last Supper, do an art project and watch a video in preparation for First Communion. Grade three is talking about all sacraments and creating a sacrament game. Grade four is talking about Reconciliation and forgiveness. They will be using an activity pamphlet to learn more about the Sacrament. Grade five is preparing for Reconciliation with an examination of conscience activity. There are examples for discussion and a prayer service.

All classes begin at 5:30 PM with temperatures taken and masks worn by all, parents, children and catechists.

6<sup>th</sup> grade students/parents Bible study will resume with session 4 of the Ascension Press "Encounter" program videos on the Old Testament: Desert Wanderings and Conquest and Judges. Student/parent teams will be using their Bibles for a Bible search as well as looking up the upcoming Sunday Gospel. The Saint lesson is about St. Helena, there is a QR code which contains a very informative video/movie on St. Helena. The Theme for this class is Celebrating Mass with a puzzle activity. There will be handouts and worksheets for more at home study of the Mass.

Our seventh grade families will discuss the question, "If you decided to commit your whole life to doing good what would you do?" Through scripture reading this question will be explored in light of the teachings of Jesus. Continuing with the preparation process for Confirmation the candidates will discover that the Apostles began the Church's public ministry at Pentecost, ritual actions of the Sacrament, ways in which Baptism and Eucharist are connected to Confirmation. The saint lesson will be on Venerable Mother Henriette DeLille. Closing prayer will be the Daily Examen.

Our Confirmation candidates will gather on January 31 for their

workshop on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Our Pastor Fr. Fran will speak on the ways in which ritual actions in the Sacrament

# St. Blaisé and the Blessing of Throats

Saint Blaisé was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. According to various accounts, he was a physician before becoming a

bishop. He was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy with nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the eighth century he has been involved on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat.

The use of candles for the blessing of the throat stems from the candles that Blaisé used while in prison. When an old woman's pig had been miraculously rescued from a wolf by Saint Blaisé, she would visit him in prison, bringing him food and candles to bring him light in his dark cell.



# Effective January 1, 2022 PAAD and Senior Gold limits will increase by 10,000 each.

This increases the income eligibility limits established in the Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD) program to \$38,769 for single persons and \$45,270 combined income for married couples. Under the Senior Gold Prescription Discount Program, income eligibility limits are \$10,000 higher than PAAD income eligibility limits. Therefore, the bill will increase income eligibility limits under the Senior Gold Prescription Discount program to \$48,769 for single persons and \$55,270 combined income for married couples. If you need assistance in filling out an application call Senior Services to schedule an appointment (609) 494-8861.
