

A Letter From The Pastor...



Love in the Time of Covid

When I lived in Bolivia in the mid-90's I kept hearing about this book, Love in the Time of Cholera, published in 1985 and written by the Colombian author, Grabriel García Márquez. Despite all the accolades and recommendations, I must confess, I never read the book, but for some reason the name always stuck with me. Of course, since March of 2020 the title of that book kept ringing in my ear, but only with a slight nuance, Love in the time of Covid.

I know I join many people who welcomed the bishop's lifting of the restrictions that had been in place for over 14 months. I am also thankful that we are starting to get back to "normal," although I am still not sure what the new normal will look like down the road. It certainly does appear that we are heading in the right direction and we continue to pray that that is true.

I have received a few requests, not many, but enough to warrant this letter to you, the parish, about the decision to hold off on the reception of communion on the tongue. I can appreciate the desire to receive Holy Communion on the tongue out of reverence and great respect for the reception of sacramental presence of Christ. It has been a long tradition within our Latin Rite celebration of the Eucharist. In Bishop O'Connell's, May 26, 2021, Revisions of Current Covid Protocols, he "strongly encourages" the reception of Holy Communion in the hand but has also left the opportunity for Communion to be received on the tongue. When I spoke with him in September, not long after I arrived as the new pastor, he did say that the ultimate choice would be at the discretion of the pastor. In the same statement, Bishop O'Connell also reminded us that "the COVID-19 pandemic remains active" and has said that "all ministers of Holy Communion should wear masks while distributing the Holy Eucharist."

On numerous occasions I have spoken with the other friars in the house and we continue to believe that for the safety of the entire community, while we remain in an active pandemic, communion will only be distributed in the hand. Unlike many parishes where the majority of the congregation remains consistent, our population grows and changes on a weekly basis. That is a good thing. It is wonderful to welcome so many people from all different areas, but that does place us in a different reality than most parishes. The statistics tell us that while many are vaccinated there does remain a large segment of our population that is not. While we remain in a national and global pandemic the continued use of hand sanitizers, the wearing of masks by those distributing Communion, along with the reception of Communion in the hand, I believe, is the safest way to distribute Holy Communion for the entire community.

Let us continue to pray for the end to this pandemic, for those who are sick and those who have died because of it, and all those working to move us forward.

May God continue to bless you with peace and all good.

Welcome to summer on Long Beach Island. The sun comes out, the ocean warms up, and the beach awaits.

The best part is that all of our summer friends and visitors return to share the beauty of God's creation.

The population on the island multiplies many times over, and just like the restaurants and shops looking for help, we as a parish church also need many ministers to serve our brothers and sisters. Our parish is not just one church as you know, but four churches that must share the same ministers. Weekly Reflections...

Saints of God, the Lord be with you!

Today's Gospel according to Mark (4:35-41) recounts the well-known story of Jesus asleep in the boat while a storm rages. The disciples, in a panic, wake Him up and all Jesus needs to do to stop the storm is to say, "Quiet! Be still!" I don't know about you, but during the past year I have often prayed that God would stop the storm of Covid 19. Yet that storm raged on, and continues to rage on in many parts of the world. So what gives?

I think the wisdom of the Church is found in the fact that the Gospel on this Sunday is tied to the first reading from the Book of Job. The story of Job was written for people of faith struggling to hold onto faith during a time of prolonged suffering. As I read Job, I've come to see that God does not send "storms" no matter how we define them, but allows them to occur for a reason. We may never know the reason, but no matter what we are going through, we must hold onto the knowledge that God is bigger than any storm, and that God can use every storm for our good. God doesn't send storms; God gives every storm a limit, and even if we die, we are not destroyed.

I guess what I am trying to say is that suffering is a mystery to which we can give no good answer. However, the greatest of all Mysteries, is the mystery of God. Jesus is the incarnation of the Mystery and He shows us that the Mystery of All Mysteries is concerned with our welfare, and that God is a God Who is Love. And isn't love itself a Mystery?

What got me through the pandemic is remembering that we were all in this together, and that God was in control. As I write this, I see that while God didn't stop the storm of Covid 19, God did calm the storm of fear and doubt in my heart. What storm are you going through? Believe that God is bigger than your storm and has given it a limit. Ask God to bless your storm, and to use it for your betterment. Remember, "The antidote to fear is faith, and the fruit of faith is charity."


