

Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

Weekly Reflections...

This weekend the gospel of Mark has two different parts. The first is about the synagogue official Jairus' daughter. The second is about a woman in need of healing for 12 years. She sought many doctors and got no relief, she only got worse. Adding to the problem, she spent all the money that she had. Having heard about Jesus the woman decided to take a chance and said "if I only touch his clothes I will be cured". She did so and immediately she felt the healing in her body. Jesus was aware of the healing power going out of him! He turned and said "who touched me". I imagine the crowd may have been like the crowd on a subway at rush hour.

The disciples logically said how can you ask such a question? Everyone in our area has touched you. But not everyone had the faith to believe they could be cured. This is another time the disciples did not understand what was happening before them. The woman seeing the commotion fessed up. Jesus was not angry with her but said "your faith has saved you." He did not say "cure her" but rather he said "saved you." This is a most unusual gospel passage where the healing power was transferred to another person without Jesus' knowledge. I do not think any other gospel has a similar healing.

There are two words that this reading reminds me of, "healing" and "cured". One of our friars, an older wiser friar named Brennan Connelly defined the difference of cured and healed. His mother had bouts of arthritis. He said his mother was never cured of that but she was healed. I would imagine she was healed in her spiritual life. She was also saved by her faith.

My pray for us is that we may be saved and healed by our faith in Jesus on the journey to the Kingdom.

Welcome to summer on Long Beach Island. The sun comes out, the ocean warms up, and the beach awaits.

The best part is that all of our summer friends and visitors return to share the beauty of God's creation.

The population on the island multiplies many times over, and just like the restaurants and shops looking for help, we as a parish church also need many ministers to serve our brothers and sisters. Our parish is not just one church as you know, but four churches that must share the same ministers. The number of Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Ministers of Hospitality/Ushers, and Altar Servers that we need per Mass is approximately 19. During the summer we have 18 Masses on a weekend which means we need 304 ministers each weekend!! *We need you!*

"Ministry is, by its very nature, relational. Spiritual Direction



Are you interested in a deeper relationship with God? Do you experience a desire to pray always? Are you searching for a better understanding of the actions of God's grace in your life?

Spiritual Direction is not about problem solving. It is neither counseling nor therapy. It is about enhancing one's prayer life. Directors help people recognize and respond to God's will in their life experiences. One Director summed up the process this way, "All I do is listen. People already have a spiritual life; they are not starting here. Often they need relief from the pressure that they are not doing the right thing. I help them see the goodness in where they are on their journey, not where they think they're supposed to be." God is the real spiritual director.

The Diocese of Trenton has several training programs called an internship. These are two or three year programs focusing on deepening one's own spiritual life and on learning the dynamics of Spiritual Direction. Upon completion of the program a person receives a Certificate from the Diocese.

Our parish has four certified Spiritual Directors.


