

A Letter From The Pastor...

The Eucharist is what holds us together and together we are the Body of Christ. For over 2000 years the celebration of the Eucharistic has been the "center and the summit" of our celebration. The General Instruction on the Roman Missal goes on to tell us that the Eucharist Prayer is a "prayer of thanksgiving and sanctification. The priest invites the people to lift up their hearts to the Lord in prayer and thanksgiving; he unites the congregation with himself in the prayer that he addresses in the name of the entire community to God the Father through Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit. Furthermore, the meaning of the Prayer is that the entire congregation of the faithful should join itself with Christ in confessing the great deeds of God and in the offering of Sacrifice. The Eucharistic Prayer demands that all listen to it with reverence and in silence."

In the twelfth chapter of St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians we hear that beautiful image of the unity of the body although made from many different parts.

Today I would like to recognize our maintenance team. They are the folks who typically work behind the scene to make sure that our buildings are in fine working order. They clean on a regular basis, our churches are decorated for the different seasons, and during Covid, disinfected our churches between Masses and the Center before a new day began.

Dan Rodriguez is the Director of Maintenance. He and his team are very attentive to our ever changing needs and repairs. As one would expect, those needs can, and often do, change daily when living on a barrier island, and in a very active parish like ours, those set ups and take downs happen often! Those who pray in our Brant Beach church have seen one aspect of their work in progress. They are transforming the stage in our Church Hall into usable storage space. Who can't use more storage space? They also transformed two class rooms and a hallway in the Center into two larger rooms. One is now used for storage for our Food Pantry and the other classroom can accommodate more people. They do excellent work!

Kudos to our Maintenance Team, members of the Body of Christ. May God continue to bless you and all the work that you do for us and may God's Peace and All Good be with us always.

They brought the comfort and joy of the Mass in a time of chaos and uncertainty. They were the Body of Christ for others. Then there were the ushers who stood out in the parking lot on Sundays in all kinds of weather to distribute Holy Communion to those who could not attend Mass. They brought nourishment and sustenance to their brothers and sisters. They were the Body of Christ for others.

Almost one year ago, I suffered a devastating loss. My beloved husband Jim died. Ours had been a life filled with love, laughter, and the blessings of a beautiful family. We lived our marriage vows for 55 years. We went through good times and bad, sickness and health, until death did us part. My heart was broken. I was so grateful to God for the beautiful years he had given us. Right from the beginning, my St. Francis Parish community became my strength and comfort. They cared for me, they were shoulders to cry on, ears to listen, prayers to sustain me, cards, Masses, phone calls, understanding. They were the Body of Christ for me.

As we receive the Body and Blood of Christ, we know that Jesus' sacrifice gave the world eternal salvation, and as followers of Christ we have something to give - ourselves - to each other.
