A Letter From The Pastor...





Synod... There's that word again!

Do you remember Ed Koch? When he was mayor of New York City he would always ask, in his thick New York accent, "So how'm I doin'?" Not a bad question to keep asking

ourselves!

Right now the Catholic Church is in the midst of asking a similar question, "How are you doing?" It is not the same as Mayor Koch's query, and the motivation is certainly different, but it is an opportunity for the church to get a better sense of the *sensus fidelium* – the sense of the faithful.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines sensus fidelium as "the supernatural appreciation of faith on the part of the whole people, when, from the bishops to the last of the faithful, they manifest a universal consent in matters of faith and morals." Lumen Gentium, from the Second Vatican Council, says, "By this appreciation of the faith, aroused and sustained by the Spirit of truth, the People of God, guided by the sacred teaching authority,... receives... the faith, once for all delivered to the saints. ... The People unfailingly adheres to this faith, penetrates it more deeply with right judgment, and applies it more fully in daily life." Jesus tells us in the Gospel of Matthew [16:18] that "the gates of Hell will not prevail against it," [the Church.] Fr. Gerard O'Collins, in his book Fundamental Theology, defines church as "the Lord's people that carries forward the living tradition of essential beliefs throughout history, with the Bishops overseeing that this tradition does not pursue the way of

Everyone is invited to participate in these prayerful conversations. The first will be after the 10 AM Mass today, Sunday, March 13th, in the Parish Center. Another will be Saturday, March 26th at 10 AM in the church hall and the third is a zoom meeting at 7 PM on Wednesday, March 23rd. Please see the letter in today's bulletin for more details. If you have not signed up for today's meeting, don't worry. Just go! I participated in a diocesan wide conversation as well as facilitated a number of these conversations in preparation for the Synod of 2023. I have found them all to be very affirming and uplifting as I listened to the love that our fellow parishioners have for the church as well as the challenges that we encounter along the path of our own lives.

I would encourage you to participate in one of these conversations. I suspect that you too will find it to be a grace-filled experience and an opportunity to witness the Holy Spirit in action.

Unlike Mayor Koch's appeal, this is not a vote on truth or doctrine. This is not a debate where one side tries to convince the other that they are right. This is simply a time to listen to the church, from the individual voices at a specific meeting, as well as the collective voice of the *sensus fidelium* when ultimately our voice will be added to the collected responses. Fear not, the Holy Spirit is always in charge.

Greetings Parishioners and Friends,

Please let us introduce ourselves – Jennifer and Anthony Mauro, co-chairs of the Synod steering committee. We are honored to have been asked to be part of the Synod of Bishops process, as St. Francis of Assisi Parish has been our spiritual home for more than 15 years.

As you may have heard, Pope Francis has called for a Synod of Bishops to meet in 2023. The overarching objective is for the Church to become a listening Church. For us to listen to each other about our faith journeys.

As part of this process, the Pope wants to hear from as many Catholics (both practicing and drifting) as possible. To that end, our parish is organizing a Spiritual Conversation Campaign. The goal of the campaign is to encourage all parishioners and all baptized Catholics to gather and offer their insights and to encounter one another in prayer and active listening. Questions will be asked, and a synopsis of each conversation will be recorded via notetaking and sent to the Diocese. All participant names will be kept in confidence, and no names will be included in the report. The Diocese will then condense and send this information on to the Vatican.

The questions are as follows:

- 1. What have been the joys and obstacles in your journeying together with the Church?
- 2. Consider the comments from the other participants in the first round. What resonated the most for you?
- 3. Reflecting on our conversation, how might the Holy Spirit be prompting you, and all of us as Church, to improve the ways we are able to journey together?

A group of parish volunteers have been trained as facilitators and notetakers. All parishioners and viewpoints will be welcomed and listened to. Open-mindedness and openheartedness will lead to prayerfulness and a reaffirming spirit within each listening session. We hope for a large number of participants. We also encourage each parishioner who plans on participating to extend an invitation to any family member, friend or acquaintance who may not be actively practicing our faith. It is important that we hear from them. Understand that we will not look to evangelize but will only provide non-judgmental listening. Our prayers will be offered to the Holy Spirit seeking guidance, discernment and support for all shared views, opinions, suggestions and hopes given by each and every active participant.

There will be *two Spiritual Conversation Meetings*, one held on Sunday, March 13, after the 10:00 AM Mass in the Parish Center and another on Saturday, March 26, at 10 AM in the Brant Beach Church Hall. There will also be a Zoom meeting at 7 PM, Wednesday, March 23. To sign up for one of these meetings, or for more information, email synod.stfrancis@gmail.com.

We pray now that the Holy Spirit will help you make the decision to participate and we extend our gratefulness in advance for you doing so.



Catholics celebrate a time in the Church when they follow more closely the way of Jesus. We take up spiritual practices and disciplines that help us identify with Jesus more as we prepare to celebrate Easter.

Our families in the Religious Education program will be reading and discussing scripture, Jesus' practice of prayer and learn what they can do as a family to prepare to journey the forty days. We will think about how we treat others. We will look beyond our own wants and desires. We will pay attention to the needs of others. We will look for some ways we can make changes in our lives to grow closer to God. During this season of Penance we will see that the Church looks simple and plain, little flowers or decorations. The priests wear purple vestments.

The art activity for the 1st through 3rd grades is to make a Lenten resolution egg. The children will choose something to do to make the world a better place and keep the egg chart to see how they are doing, as well as act out a skit about making choices. Grades 4 and 5 will re-enact the way of the cross.

Our 2nd grade children are working with their parents as they prepare for their First Eucharist. We will celebrate the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time on **March 21**st.

6th grade students/parents Bible study continues with session 6 of the Ascension Press "Encounter" program videos "Exile, Return and Maccabean Revolt", followed by a short review. Student/parent teams will use their Bibles to look up the upcoming Sunday Gospel and take time for a reflection. The Saint lesson is about St. Benedict of Palermo and includes a QR code with a video on his life. The theme for this class is Lent, handouts will include a QR code with a match game on the Stations of the Cross. We will use Loyola Press Art Print #20 an interpretation of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed after the Last Supper. There will be handouts and worksheets for more at home study on Lent.

Grade 7 Confirmation prep I candidates will be completing their candidate book this month. This session will focus on the meaning of Grace in their lives, how the will and actions of the Holy Spirit inspire the use of their gifts.

As Matthew Kelly, author of Decision Point another book used in this class says "Be Bold, Be Catholic".


