Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

# Did You Know??

Did you know that St Francis Parish and Long Beach Island Community Center (St Francis Center) are both qualifying employers under the federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program (PSLF)?

Both companies are 501c3 tax exempt organizations according to the IRS. That means that full time employees who have eligible Federal Direct Student Loans can qualify for student loan forgiveness after making 120 qualifying payments (10 years) towards their student loans. Here are additional examples to reflect upon for <u>Living A</u> <u>Laudato Si' Lent 2023</u>:

March 19 – Fourth Sunday of Lent – Take a walk in your neighborhood. Try and meet someone that you don't know and observe your environment.

March 20 – <u>Solemnity of St. Joseph</u> – "Joseph can teach us how to show care; he can inspire us to work with generosity and tenderness in protecting the world that God has entrusted to us." (LS 242)

March 21 – <u>World Poetry Day</u> – read the writings of a nature poet – Mary Oliver, Langston Hughes, Emily Dickinson, Walt Whitman, Martin Luther King.

March 22 – <u>World Water Day</u> – drink a glass of water with reverence as you recall the waters of your birth and baptism.

March 23 – Use only cold water and biodegradable detergent for laundry.

March 24 – Death of Archbishop Oscar Romero (+1980) who said, "The ones who have a voice must speak for those who are voiceless." How do we humans speak for the voiceless species of Earth?

March 25 – Feast of the Annunciation - "In Mary's glorified body, part of creation has reached the fullness of its beauty... hence we can ask her to enable us to look at this world with eyes of wisdom." (LS 241)


