#### Weekly Reflections...

Today's gospel has a powerful message and commandment: "Love one another. As I have loved you... This is how all will know that you are my disciples if you have love for one another."

I frequently like to see the saints for the next week. I must confess in our parish of St Joseph in East Rutherford we had a collection of stain glass windows of Franciscan Saints.

One that I was not familiar with was a Third Order Woman named **St. Margaret of Cortona**, born in 1247. At the age of 7 her mother died and her father was not a great deal of help in raising her. They said she had a rare beauty. I would compare her life at this point to Madonna's Song, a *Material Girl*. The man she was in relationship with was murdered. The man's dog brought Margaret to the unfortunate man's body. This terrible scene made her reevaluate her life and started out on a positive direction. She was led by Divine Grace and started to look at the spirituality in her life. She joined the Third Order following a life of penance and prayer. In the spirit of St Francis, she started taking care of the poor and ill. After years of penance she was called by God to come home to the Kingdom of God, February 22, 1297. Her feast day is May 16.

A second Friar Brother I was not familiar with was **St. Paschal Baylon**. He was born on Pentecost in 1540 in Spain. His family was poor. To help his family he would take care of the stranger's cattle. He made such a wonderful presence that the family he worked for wanted to adopt him. That great honor was not to be; he wanted to be a friar and beggar. His spirituality centered on the Devotion of the Blessed Sacrament.

Both these Franciscan Saints came from humble beginnings and witnessed to God's love by service to the poor and the outcasts in society. His feast day is May 17, the same day he died in 1592.



In preparation for Easter, grades one through four will have an opportunity to experience the events of the week before and after Easter. Children will be using the Easter Story Eggs to tell the story of the Resurrection. In addition, they will be introduced to the Pascal candle by making a representational candle using styrofoam, a sharpie, tissue paper and cloves for the nails at Jesus' feet and hands. Grade five received their First Reconciliation with many family members participating in the Sacrament as well.

Grade six will conclude their formal classes with instruction – The Messianic Fulfillment. Discussion will include the Gospel writers' meaning of "disciple", why the twelve were chosen, why Jesus had to die and the Emmaus story. The Encounter book will concentrate on God's plan and the important part each person has in His plan for salvation. He has a mission that only you can carry out. The Saint of the week is Elizabeth of the Trinity.

Grade seven will have a retreat as their last class. It will begin with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The theme is "Filling Your Spiritual Tool Box". There will be special break-out sessions offering ideas on how the pre-Confirmation candidates can prepare as they move on to the last phase of Confirmation preparation in the Fall.

Confirmation for the 2022 candidates will be on April 29<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 pm. The presider will be Bishop O'Connell.

First Eucharist will be celebrated on May 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> and again May 15<sup>th</sup>.

Family Faith will close the year on May 19<sup>th</sup> with a prayer service and the crowning of the Blessed Mother.






