## Weekly Reflections...

On April 23, 2021, 33 of our young parishioners received the Sacrament of Confirmation completing their full initiation as members of the Catholic Church that began at their Baptism. The Gift of the Holy Spirit is confirmed, strengthened and perfected for living the Christian life and spreading the faith to others. It strengthens us for discipleship to Christ. The gifts of the Holy Spirit are:

**Wisdom:** The wise person sees where the Spirit of God is at work and is able to share that insight with others. Through wisdom, the wonders of nature, every event in history, and all the ups and downs of our life take on deeper meaning and purpose. Wisdom helps us to see that the world is only a temporary place for us, that Heaven is our true home. It helps us to set our hearts on the things that really count in life, such as God, virtue and prayer. Desire for the things of God direct our life and actions to His honor and glory.

**Understanding:** The ability to comprehend how a person must live her or his life as a follower of Jesus. The gift of understanding helps Christians realize that the Gospel tells them not just who Jesus is; it also tells them who <u>they</u> are. Understanding gives us an insight into the mysteries of faith and helps us to explain the faith to others.

**<u>Right Judgment</u>**: This is sometimes called good counsel. Right Judgment is the ability to know the difference between right and wrong and then to choose what is good. It helps us to make correct decisions about God's will for our lives and warns us of the deceits of the devil and of dangers to our salvation.

<u>Courage</u> (or fortitude): The gift of Courage enables us to take risks and to overcome fear as we try to live out the Gospel of Jesus. Courage gives us the strength to be faithful to Christ even when it is difficult to do so. Courage strengthens us to do the will of God in all things.

**Knowledge:** The gift of knowledge gives the ability to comprehend the basic meaning and message of Jesus. Knowledge helps us to see everything in life in relation to God and eternity. It enables us to discover the will of God in all things.

**Reverence:** Sometimes called piety, this gift gives the Christian a deep sense of respect for God, but with a warmth and familiarity. Jesus called God "Abba", which is more like Daddy than Father. Reverence inspires us to worship God and to love Him as our Father. Reverence is love of God as a Father and obedience to Him because we love Him.

**Fear of the Lord:** This is sometimes called "awe and wonder". Though we approach God with the trust of little children, we are also aware of God's unlimited power and awareness of what we do. Fear of the Lord shows us the evil of sin and helps us to live in God's grace. It is also called "wonder and awe" in God's presence because it reminds us that He is great and all-powerful.

We read in St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians that: "there are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit."

Let us pray and listen to the workings of the Spirit in our lives. Our gifts are important to the building up of the Body of Christ, his Church in the world today! Peace be with you, Judy Clayton




