A Letter From The Pastor...





Watch Out for Texts or Emails

I wasn't in the parish for more than a month when a trusted parishioner called me and asked if I really needed gift cards. I said, "What are you talking about?" She explained that she received a text from me saying that I needed help. She also told me that she would get similar texts from Fr. Jim when he was the pastor.

I know folks have also received emails from me asking for gift cards, or help of some sort. We all know that the internet has changed our

world. It has changed how we interact with people, it has changed the way we shop and it has also changed the way that people can take advantage of us. Fraud is nothing new. Sadly, they have just found easier ways to access thousand if not hundreds of thousands of people at one time. I do have to give them credit. They know you are good people and of course you would want to help in as much as you can. I have, and I will,

ask you for help and support but I promise you I will NEVER ask for your help with a general email or with a text. If I am stranded somewhere or too busy that I can't talk to you at that moment, please know that I will be OK! ;o)

I did a quick search online [ironically] for some tips to keep in mind if you are wondering if an email is legitimate or not. This is an abridged version so I would encourage you read the article online at <u>How to Tell</u> If an Email Is Fake: 7 Tips to Spot a Fake Email (sectigostore.com) 7 Tips for How to Tell If an Email Is Fake

- 1. Inspect the email header to verify the sender's address is legitimate. Mine will always be from @stfrancislbi.org.

 2. Watch out for uncommon use of the "bcc" field. A serious email
- will most likely be directed to you, not "blind copied" in a group
- 3. Always be cautions of embedded links within an email. Some links embedded within emails may be legitimate but it's always safe to go directly to the business' website to access what you need. The link in within a fake email can take you places you don't want to go.
- 4. Don't ignore unusual spelling and grammatical errors.
- 5. Ask yourself whether the language seems fishy, pushy, or urgent.
- 6. Ask yourself if the email attachments are unsolicited or unexpected. Never open an attachment unless you know the email is definitely from a person you trust. If you are in doubt call the sender directly. Don't email them by hitting reply. It will most likely take you to the hacker!
- 7. Be Vigilant (Even if the email is from a legit email address) The above tips will help you to know if an email is fake when the attacks use a fake email address. But what if you get an unusual or unsolicited email from a friend or relative from their authentic email address? There are different types of malware and cyber-attacks that can corrupt a users' devices and send phishing emails on their behalf to other victims. There's no exact way to define an "unusual email," but just use your instincts. Something about the email may look or feel "off."

What to do if an email is fake? Ignoring such fake emails won't be enough. You should delete phishing emails as soon as you get them, BUT before deleting them, you should block the sender. Click on the More (three vertical dots) option on the email. That should lead you to the option to block a sender.

Weekly Reflections...

Saints of God, the Lord be with you.

Today's Gospel [Mark 12:38-44] juxtaposes unscrupulous religious lawyers who are preoccupied with obtaining wealth and status, who "devour the houses of widows and recite lengthy prayers." On the other hand Jesus observes a poor widow who gives all she has to live on in order to support the Temple and all its' attendants. Our first reading from the

First Book of Kings [17:10-16] highlights how God through the prophet Elijah cared for a poor widow during a famine. It seems to me, that the widow is the hinge that opens the Scriptures for us this weekend.

Women had no rights in the ancient world, and needed the support and protection of a husband in order to live. I don't think it a stretch to say that being a widow was one of the most precarious positions a woman could find herself in. What I find missing in today's Gospel is any comfort or support that the Temple gave to this, or any, widow.

Many of you reading this might be widows or widowers. I can never imagine losing a spouse. Like the widow in the first reading, you might be hungering for more than just bread, but for the companionship that is now missing. Like the widow in the Gospel you might be concerned about your finances. You might be mad at God, or your departed spouse and find it difficult to pray. And if you do pray, sometimes words and prayers might seem empty to you.

I'd like to remind you of a prayer said at a wake, "We believe that all the ties of friendship and affection which knit us as one throughout our lives DO NOT unravel with death." Talk to your spouse as you pray and ask for strength and guidance. Be patient with yourself. And as you struggle to reimagine your "new normal" I only hope that you turn to, and find, more than just words of comfort and support here. My prayer is that you find a loving and supportive presence here at St. Francis as well.



An Invitation to Contemplative Living





MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT:

St. Francis Senior Services staff are trained State Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors for assistance in Medicare A, B, C or D information. Do you know the difference? Medicare A primarily pays for a stay in the hospital, or a skilled nursing facility, B is for doctor's services and outpatient services such as lab tests, C pays for the Medicare Advantage or managed care alternative to traditional Medicare and D of course is the prescription drug plan.

Soon Medicare beneficiaries will once again need to make a decision about their prescription drug coverage. Medicare Part D open enrollment period runs through December 7th. During this time, people with Medicare can sign up for a prescription drug plan or switch their current Medicare Part D plan in order to have the best coverage beginning January of 2020. And yes, it's best to check each year for changes. Open enrollment is also the perfect time to review your Medicare Advantage plan with a SHIP Counselor to be notified of any changes. What if you cannot afford a Medicare Part D plan? There is federal assistance available for people with Medicare who have limited income and resources. If you qualify, you can receive assistance with premiums, deductibles and prescription co-payments. For an appointment please call (609) 978-6221. 
