### A Letter From The Pastor...





Two Things

Hello good people. This weekend I only have two things that I would like to highlight.

As was announced at the Masses last weekend, if you would like to place a picture of a loved one who has died in our Remembrance Memorial, please feel free to

do so. As a community of hope we remember in our prayer all of those who have died as we also pray for those who grieve their loss. Our Remembrance Memorial reminds us to pray for one another.

Next Sunday we bring the liturgical year to a close as we celebrate The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. That is why the readings at Mass for the past few weeks have focused on the "end times," as in today's readings we hear about the "days after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light." It sounds scary and overwhelming, and at times it very much is. But, of course, as people of faith in the Resurrection we know that there is no darkness that can put out the light of Christ.

As we contemplate the "end times" we also remember that we too must look at our life in the context of our own death. At times that can be a daunting and sobering task. It is for that reason St. Paul reminded the community in Thessalonica, "let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be awake and sober." (1 Thessalonians 5:6) We are a people of great faith that tells us that life is changed, not ended. Let us continue to live the hope of that faith as we walk with one another today and every day on our journey to the fullness of God's Kingdom.

The other point of interest I would like to share with you is not nearly as important, yet, very relevant to our common worship. A few weeks ago I shared with you that we will be getting new speakers for the Brant Beach Church. I want to let you know that Michele Beck, our Director of Music, informed me that they are on back order. Our hope is they will be in by Christmas but we were told that it could also be January.

As we continue to adjust to the curve balls life throws at us we hold on to what is truly important. This month of November reminds us what is important, that even death has no power over us. We can wait for the speakers and will be grateful when they arrive.

This week is the old Christ the King Sunday. But I'm looking ahead to advent! That's next weekend.

One of our family memories and traditions was preparing for Christmas with a live tree. My father was an engineer and believed in a live Christmas tree for safety. This was a major production involving all our parents and children. First Dad had to pick a spot, using a yard plan and slider ruler. Then my

brother Matt and I would dig a hole. The ground was not yet frozen. We then put the unfrozen dirt in a wheel barrel and put that into the heated garage. We covered the other hole up with a plywood board which would eventually be covered with snow by Christmas. We brought the tree up the stairs into the house. Children in front pulling and children in back pushing the tree. It reminded me of building the pyramids.

Next my oldest sister supervised the tree trimming. Matt and I were fired because we did not do a good enough job. Finally we had to water the live tree every day.

Lights, camera, action! The Gang did a really good job by the way.

Christmas would come and my mother would say. "enough with the tree already." Take it out to the garden. We planted the tree first by putting peat moss in the hole, then the tree with all its roots, next the warm dirt from the heated garage. In all the years we did this Christmas tradition we only lost one tree. Amazing!

This reminds me of Christmas joy and family. Everyone involved working together to celebrate a new birth and a new beginning.


Christmas was the beginning of a new relationship, incarnation and Emanuel "God among us".



#### MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT:

St. Francis Senior Services staff are trained State Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors for assistance in Medicare A, B, C or D information. Do you know the difference? Medicare A primarily pays for a stay in the hospital, or a skilled nursing facility, B is for doctor's services and outpatient services such as lab tests, C pays for the Medicare Advantage or managed care alternative to traditional Medicare and D of course is the prescription drug plan.

Soon Medicare beneficiaries will once again need to make a decision about their prescription drug coverage. Medicare Part D open enrollment period runs through December 7<sup>th</sup>. During this time, people with Medicare can sign up for a prescription drug plan or switch their current Medicare Part D plan in order to have the best coverage beginning January of 2020. And yes, it's best to check each year for changes. Open enrollment is also the perfect time to review your Medicare Advantage plan with a SHIP Counselor to be notified of any changes. What if you cannot afford a Medicare Part D plan? There is federal assistance available for people with Medicare who have limited income and resources. If you qualify, you can receive assistance with premiums, deductibles and prescription co-payments. For an appointment please call (609) 978-6221. 
