

A Letter From The Pastor...





End of Year Budget Report

The weekend of August 1, 2021, I introduced the parish to our Parish Finance Council and spoke of their role, in part, assisting me to manage "the temporal goods of the church." As outlined in the Diocese of Trenton's, "Norms for Parish Finance Council," another role they have is to "assist in the publication of an annual financial report available to parishioners."

We had planned on publishing the report to the parish in October once the community was gathered in one church. However, because of my father's death the schedule was delayed. It does seem fitting to present the report to you as we end the Liturgical Year and prepare to begin again with Advent next Sunday.

Joe Mack, chair of the Parish Finance Council, will be speaking at all the Masses this weekend to offer a general overview of the financial status of our parish. He along with the rest of the council have continued to meet with me on a monthly basis. The names and contact information of our Parish Finance Council are listed below. They

have all agreed to be available to answer any questions you may have about the parish finances.

The Parish Report Sub-Committee was chaired by Cecelia Fowler. She and the committee worked very closely with Stacey Kelsall, the comptroller for the parish and center. They also met on a regular basis to discuss and plan the report that is before you today. I think they did an excellent job explaining the numbers as well as setting the context of the financial state of the parish.

For those accustomed to reading financial reports please allow me to offer some brief explanations for those who are not. The parish operates on a fiscal year of July 1 – June 30. For comparison, this report shows the *actual* accounting [what we spent] for FY 19 [the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2019,] FY 20, FY 21. Also included in the report is the budget that we created for FY 21 before that fiscal year actually began. At that point it was only a prediction of income and expenses. It was meant as a guide to make sure that we stayed within our means when purchasing services or items as well as making sure that our income was realistic and stable so to meet those expenditures.

That being said, there are a few things that I would like to bring to your attention.

First of all, I would like to say thank you! We ended the first full fiscal year within this Covid pandemic in the black! You will see on the bottom of the FY 21 Actual column that we ended the year with a surplus of \$198,699.21. That is great news! That surplus is due, in part, to some cutbacks and realignments, careful management by our directors, and a forgivable PPP [Paycheck Protection Program] loan of \$230,000, an SBA-backed loan that helped businesses keep their workforce employed during the COVID-19 crisis. But the real reason we were able to cross the threshold was because of you, our parish community, and your response to my appeal for help last year with the *Christmas 2020 Giving Fund*. Your contributions totaled \$317,000. Without your incredibly generous response we would have ended FY 21 with a deficit of (\$118,300.79.)

You will also notice that our actual expenses in FY 21 was \$17,912.49 less that what we had predicted we would spend. The budget also indicated that we would end the year with a deficit of (\$101,892.00). That is not that far off from where would have been without the *Christmas 2020 Giving Fund*.

All in all, I think it was a very successful year, financially.

There are many people to thank for making that happen. Kudos to our directors who kept a watchful eye on their expenses. Thank you to Stacey Kelsall for her diligent care of our accounting, and many, many thanks to our Parish Finance Council for their dedication to our parish and sage advice to me during my first year as pastor of St. Francis Parish. A special thanks to Cecelia and the Parish Report Sub-Committee for their hard work preparing this report for you.

But of course, the greatest thanks goes out to you, our parish community. Your dedication and commitment to our parish community is the only thing that allows us to continue to be who we are for one another. Thank you! We are a great community and I am so happy to be back with you!

May God continue to bless you and your families. May we always know the riches we have in one another as we all walk together in and through the unfolding of God's mysterious presence in our midst.

Please allow me to also wish each of you a wonderful Thanksgiving Day. We have much to be thankful. God is good, and so are the people of God!

May you be blessed with peace and all good!



Bigger than Disney

Disney World with its Magic Kingdom makes a lot people happy. It is its own place, set apart and refreshingly different from the real world. For some people the Kingdom of Jesus is also a fantasy, an illusion like the Magic Kingdom of Disney. The promise of the Kingdom of Jesus Christ is so far beyond human beings that they assume that it cannot be true. So they look for something else.

In 1925 when Pope Pius XI created the Feast of Christ the King, he was thinking of the something else. On his mind were nationalism and secular ideologies which he believed threaten the well-being of humankind, the dignity of the human person, and the church

Jesus never wanted to acknowledge that he was a King, but finally obliquely acknowledged it before Pilate. But he was very clear that his kingdom was like no other. "My kingdom is not of this world." It is not a place or an organization. It is grander than anything that might make a false claim on our loyalty and it defies everything that tears people down and rips communities apart, the things that worried Pius XI.

Those who are loyal to Christ the King resist whatever tries to take the place of God in human hearts and minds. Even more, they work to build up, to enlighten, to heal, to restore and to reconcile. They continue the mission of the Christ the King. These things Pilate and those like him could never understand.

Our own Saint Francis styled himself Herald of the Great King. As brothers and sisters in the Kingdom, aren't we heralds, too?

Thy Kingdom come!

MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT:

St. Francis Senior Services staff are trained State Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors for assistance in Medicare A, B, C or D information. Do you know the difference? Medicare A primarily pays for a stay in the hospital, or a skilled nursing facility, B is for doctor's services and outpatient services such as lab tests, C pays for the Medicare Advantage or managed care alternative to traditional Medicare and D of course is the prescription drug plan.

Soon Medicare beneficiaries will once again need to make a decision about their prescription drug coverage. Medicare Part D open enrollment period runs through December 7th. During this time, people with Medicare can sign up for a prescription drug plan or switch their current Medicare Part D plan in order to have the best coverage beginning January of 2020. And yes, it's best to check each year for changes. Open enrollment is also the perfect time to review your Medicare Advantage plan with a SHIP Counselor to be notified of any changes. What if you cannot afford a Medicare Part D plan? There is federal assistance available for people with Medicare who have limited income and resources. If you qualify, you can receive assistance with premiums, deductibles and prescription co-payments. For an appointment please call (609) 978-6221. 
