

Family Faith: For children in grades one through eight. Please call Judith Clayton at (609) 494-8813 ext. 153 for more information.

Marriage: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

Pastoral Visitations: Please notify the Parish Office if you or any of your loved ones are ill, homebound, in SOMC, nursing homes or rehabilitation centers.

She quickly came to him bearing the almond confections and the cloth she used to make the brother's robes, candles, incense, and a beautiful white burial cloth. Since women were not allowed into the room where Francis lay, he called out to her "Brother Jacoba" and she was able to enter. At the Transitus this year, the Secular Franciscans will be distributing the homemade almond cookies. We sincerely hope you will join us at 5:00 PM on October 3rd to celebrate this beautiful and spiritual service.

An Invitation to Contemplative Living


