

Weekly Reflections...



Fr. John Frambes, OFM, Pastoral

These are the October days when we celebrate Saint Francis and his story is retold as it has been since his death in 1226. Unless you write an autobiography or memoir, you don't get to tell your own story. The story tellers all say what *they* think is important.

Brother Thomas of Celano, the first official biographer, wrote two versions of the life of Francis. The first depicted

him as a unique and somewhat unconventional follower of the Gospel. His second try described Francis as a more typical saint ready for canonization. A generation later, Saint Bonaventure, the minister general of the friars, composed a new official biography. And ordered that all copies of any previous biographies should be destroyed! Stay on message! (Fortunately, Bonaventure was not the boss of Benedictine monks and they kept the older biographies in their libraries.)

How do *we* tell the story? The popular image of Francis now is a gentle, kind person who loved children and the poor. He was always sympathetic and encouraging. He reconciled enemies and preached peace. He preached to birds,too. He is the patron saint of the environment. Perhaps we emphasize these things because our times need a saint like that.

Yet while niceness is nice, I am drawn to that wild saint who was ruthless in living the Gospel. I can't measure up to him, but I need the challenge.

"October 4 is the day the Church sets aside to celebrate St. Francis of Assisi's *dies natalis*—his birth into eternal life. Francis is easily one of the Church's most beloved and venerated saints. Thus, even the *vigil* of his death is celebrated in style. October 3 is the vigil of his passing over and bears a special name - his *Transitus*. The word is derived from the Latin meaning "passage," "crossing" or "going over." The feast has always been an important part of Franciscan spirituality. A gentle turning to God in the final, ultimate mystery - the passing over or, the *turning* over, of one's soul to its Lover and Author."



Spiritual Direction

Are you interested in a deeper relationship with God? Do you experience a desire to pray always? Are you searching for a better understanding of the actions of God's grace in your life?

Spiritual Direction is not about problem solving. It is neither counseling nor therapy. It is about enhancing one's prayer life. Directors help people recognize and respond to God's will in their life experiences. One Director summed up the process this way, "All I do is listen. People already have a spiritual life; they are not starting here. Often they need relief from the pressure that they are not doing the right thing. I help them see the goodness in where they are on their journey, not where they think they're supposed to be." God is the real spiritual director.

The Diocese of Trenton has several training programs called an internship. These are two or three year programs focusing on deepening one's own spiritual life and on learning the dynamics of Spiritual Direction. Upon completion of the program a person receives a Certificate from the Diocese.

Our parish has five certified Spiritual Directors.



Did You Know??

Throughout the Covid-19 pandemic it has been the responsibility of the Human Resources Director, along with the Executive Director of the Community Center and the Pastor of St Francis Parish to implement policies which are aimed at keeping both the staff of the Parish and Center and the community members we serve, safe and healthy.
