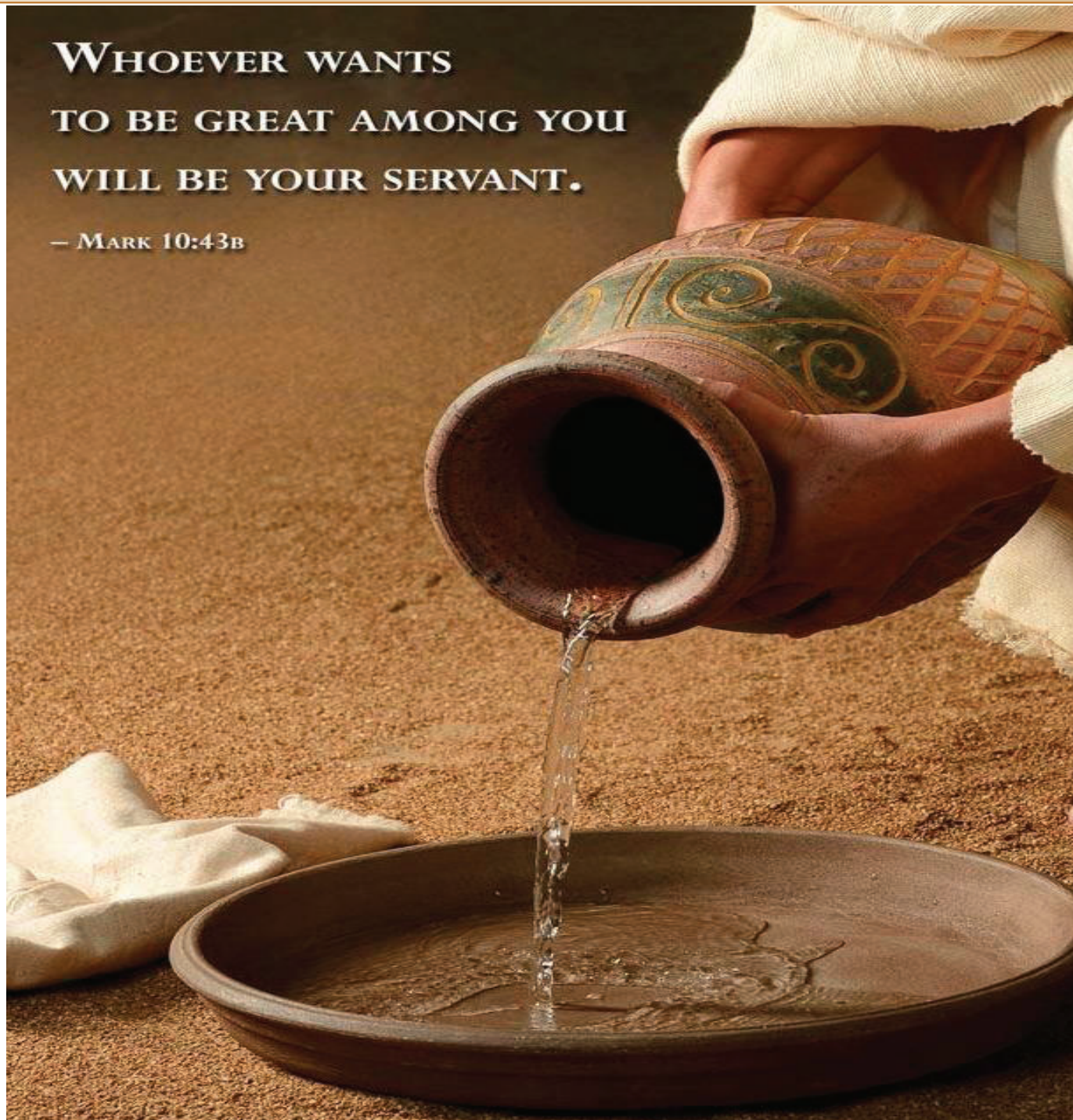

Weekly Reflections...

In the upcoming week we celebrate the feast day of Saint John of Capistrano. I must confess I know more about the Swallows than I do about St. John. The California Franciscan Mission was established by St. Juniper Serra in 1776. There are two different events there. The Swallows travel to and from California to Argentina (I'm told about 12,000 miles round trip) departing California in

October and returning in the northern hemisphere springtime around the feast of St. Joseph on March 19th. They then migrate back to Argentina around the feast of St. John on October 23rd. The town celebrates the arrival with the Swallow Day Parade. Usually it is a really big celebration but in the past few years Covid has decreased their festivities. I'm told its quite an event though.

But what about St. John of Capistrano? He was born June 24, 1385. In his youth he was well educated and become the governor of Perugia. Conflict arose and he was imprisoned for a period of time where he had a conversion and joined the Franciscan community in 1416. Scholars tell us he was a student of St. Bernardine of Siena. He was an outstanding preacher. In the later stages of his life he travelled to Germany to preach against the Hussites Heresy. It was noted that he cured the sick and performed other miracles. Now 70 years old, he joined a crusade against the Turks. The victory was on the feast of St. Mary of Magdalen in 1456. He died on October 23rd.

Marriage: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT:

St. Francis Senior Services staff are trained State Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors for assistance in Medicare A, B, C or D information. Do you know the difference? Medicare A primarily pays for a stay in the hospital, or a skilled nursing facility, B is for doctor's services and outpatient services such as lab tests, C pays for the Medicare Advantage or managed care alternative to traditional Medicare and D of course is the prescription drug plan.

Soon Medicare beneficiaries will once again need to make a decision about their prescription drug coverage. Medicare Part D open enrollment period begins on **October 15th and runs through December 7th**. During this time, people with Medicare can sign up for a prescription drug plan or switch their current Medicare Part D plan in order to have the best coverage beginning January of 2020. And yes, it's best to check each year for changes. Open enrollment is also the perfect time to review your Medicare Advantage plan with a SHIP Counselor to be notified of any changes. What if you cannot afford a Medicare Part D plan? There is federal assistance available for people with Medicare who have limited income and resources. If you qualify, you can receive assistance with premiums, deductibles and prescription co-payments. For an appointment please call (609) 978-6221. 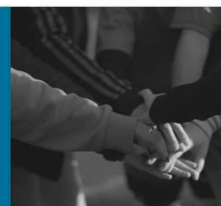
