A Letter From The Pastor...





All Hallow Eve – Vigil of All Saints Day

When I was young, I loved Halloween. Getting dressed up and walking around the neighborhood with my friends collecting as much candy as possible. I remember returning home after dark and counting all the pieces of candy on my bed. What a treasure! Of course, as I got older I realize that it was actually a treasure

for our family dentist, but that's another story.

I also learned that Halloween emerged out of our Catholic tradition. It was one of those eureka moments when I realized that Halloween was actually All Hallows' Eve, the night before the church celebrates All Saints' Day. The celebration of All Saints Day incorporated some of the traditions of Samhain (pronounced sow-in), the ancient Celtic festival when people would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts. Today we call it Halloween.

Although that is still a fun celebration for the children and for the child in all of us, it is the feasts of All Saints Day and All Souls Day that we really celebrate this time of year.

In the 8th century, Pope Gregory III chose November 1st to honor all the saints in heaven. Of course, we know and celebrate St. Francis and St. Clare. We call upon St. Anthony when we have lost something; St. Jude when we are in despair. The New Yorkers know about St. Frances Cabrini and the Philadelphians harken to St. Katharine Drexel and Saint John Neumann. On November 1st, the church recognizes that there are more people in heaven than in the Canon of Saints. The church tells us that heaven is open to our mothers and fathers, our grandparents, and our children who have gone before us.

Here at St. Francis we will celebrate All Saint's Day with a vigil Mass at 5 PM on Monday, Oct. 31st and at the 9 AM Mass on Tuesday, Nov. 1st. On Nov. 2nd, we will celebrate All Soul's Day at the 9 AM Mass and at a special Mass at 7 PM, also on Nov. 2nd, as we remember all of our family members and friends who have died during this past year.

During these few days, we celebrate the wonderful people in our lives who have gone before us, yet still woven into the fabric of our lives. Please join us on All Saint's Day and All Soul's Day as we celebrate our faith that tells us that our loved ones are now woven into the fabric of God's life.

May they all know God's peace and joy everlasting!

The commemoration of the faithful departed, following the **November 1** Solemnity of all Saints originated at the end of the 10th century in the Benedictine Monastery of Cluny. Each year the Cluniac Benedictine monks, under the guidance and initiative of Odilon, the 5th Abbot of Cluny, would commemorate all the faithful departed. The practice spread to all of the Benedictine Monasteries throughout Europe. In 1311 the celebration of the Feast of All Souls was officially adopted for the entire Church of Rome.





Did You Know??

ST. FRANCIS SENIOR SERVICES

The state of New Jersey is offering a new property tax relief program that is replacing the previous Homestead Benefit program. The Affordable New Jersey Communities for Homeowners and Renters (ANCHOR) program will benefit a large number of homeowners and includes tenants.

Homeowners

- •\$1,500 for taxpayers with 2019 gross incomes up to \$150,000
- •\$1,000 for those with 2019 gross income above \$150,000 but no higher than \$250,000.

Tenants

•\$450 for those with 2019 gross income up to \$150,000

To be eligible for this year's benefit, homeowners and renters must have occupied their primary residence on October 1, 2019 and file or be exempt from New Jersey income taxes.

How to Apply

Important instructions on how to file for the ANCHOR program started being mailed out on **September 12** to eligible residents.

- Eligible homeowners can apply online or by phone (877-658-2972).
- **Renters** can apply **online** (there is no phone option for tenants, as this is the first time this group will be eligible for property tax relief).

Payments will be issued in the form of checks or direct deposits and sent no later than May 2023 to allow time for application processing and validation. Payments will not be subject to federal or State income tax.

The deadline for filing is **December 30, 2022.**
