## The Feast of the Stigmata of St. Francis of Assisi September 17<sup>th</sup> 9:00 A.M. in the Brant Beach Church

**September 17**<sup>th</sup> is the Feast of the **Stigmata of St. Francis** of Assisi. As a Franciscan parish, we celebrate this day as a reminder of the marks that appeared on the body of St. Francis of Assisi 2 years before he died. The marks bore a resemblance to the wounds that our Lord Jesus Christ bore at his crucifixion. The word Stigmata comes from the Greek word "brand" or "mark". On the Feast of the Stigmata, we are called to remember that the marks St. Francis bore recall the wondrous love that our Lord has for us.

"Lord Jesus Christ, who reproduced in the flesh of the most blessed Francis, the sacred marks of your own sufferings, so that in a world grown cold our hearts might be filled with burning love of you, graciously enable us by his merits and prayers to bear the cross without faltering and to bring forth worthy fruits of penitence: You who are God, living and reigning with God the Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, for ever and ever. Amen."

She quickly came to him bearing the almond confections and the cloth she used to make the brother's robes, candles, incense, and a beautiful white burial cloth. Since women were not allowed into the room where Francis lay, he called out to her "Brother Jacoba" and she was able to enter. At the Transitus this year, the Secular Franciscans will be distributing the homemade almond cookies. We sincerely hope you will join us at 5:00 PM on October 3<sup>rd</sup> to celebrate this beautiful and spiritual service.

## An Invitation to Contemplative Living


