

A Letter From The Pastor...





Can You Hear Me Now?

Funny how that Verizon ad from 2002 still resonates with us. I think we can relate. There are times when we don't know if the person on the other end of our cell phone can hear us. "Can you hear me?" "CAN YOU HEAR ME NOW?" We get it because we want to make sure that they can hear us and we can hear them.

Listening to the parishioners, there has been one issue in the parish that has been consistent: the microphone system in the Brant Beach Church. About 6 months ago, at the end of Mass, a number of parishioners told me that they could not hear what was being said. After looking into it we found out that the main speaker was not working at all. We fixed that, then the south nave speaker went off line. At times the microphone pack goes on the fritz, or the batteries died, or something else happens.

I know that part of the present system is over 20 years old, because I remember it from my first time at St. Francis in the late 90s. Time constantly changes and with time, all things change. Sometimes it is technology, sometimes it is our hearing [my mother refuses to get a hearing aid] and, sometimes it's even the church itself. The present speaker system in the Brant Beach Church was designed and installed when the church was carpeted. Without that sound-absorbing flooring the echo in the church has increased tremendously. It's great for concerts and singing but not necessarily for the spoken word. Whatever the case may be, there are a lot of variables at play when using an amplification system.

Every weekend, Michele Beck, our good and faithful Director of Music, along with her league of cantors and musicians, work tirelessly to lift us up in song to praise the Lord. Between rehearsals and planning, Michele also made sure that we installed the best cameras and equipment in the Brant Beach Church for our online Masses. She continues to oversee the broadcast of our 10 AM Sunday Mass on our Facebook page and our parish website. Additionally, Michele also looks after for the microphones and amplification systems in all of the churches. THAT is no easy task.

Over the past couple of months Michele and I have worked closely with our consultant to see what we can do to upgrade the microphone and speaker system in our church in Brant Beach.

We have placed an order for new speakers and are now waiting for their delivery and installation. While the speakers in the present system are above our heads, the new speakers will be positioned at ear level. The advancement in technology has allowed the speakers to be smaller yet more effective.

Hopefully, once they are installed everyone can answer "Yes" when asked, "Can you hear me know?"






An Invitation to Contemplative Living


