A Letter From The Pastor...

FORE! ... Well not really

On Tuesday, September 14, Fr. John Frambes and I drove to the Seaview Hotel and Golf Club in Galloway Township. I didn't bring golf clubs. I didn't want to insult the course. We actually didn't go to play golf but to join over 110 other priests and Bishop O'Connell for the Annual Convocation of Priests of the Diocese of Trenton. The theme of this year's Convocation was, "Receiving and Sharing the Heart of Jesus."

The schedule of the three-day Convocation included prayer, recollection, and even some time for recreation. The keynote speaker was Bishop Gregory Studerus, an Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Newark. Prior to being ordained a bishop in June of 2020 the majority of Bp. Studerus' ministry had been in urban and multicultural settings. He was introduced to us as having a unique "sensitivity and attention to issues of cultural diversity, inclusion and compassion."

In Bp. Studerus' last presentation he shared with us that he read the Kingsbridge series of books by Ken Follett that originally began with *The Pillars of the Earth*. *Pillars*, an historical novel set in the 12th century, revolves around the emergence of Gothic architecture out of the heavy and dark Romanesque style. Despite this great architectural shift that significantly changed how churches would be built, Bp. Studerus noted that the book was really about people, their stories, and how they were able to put their lives together, or not. He then added that although our challenges are very different than those in the 1100's, our stories and our lives also contain the struggles of life and the mystery of God's great love for us. He asked the priests of the diocese to think about how we can ensure that the mystery of the loving heart of God is found in us, and, how we can share that love with the people that God puts into our lives. He suggested that we let go of the superficialities of religious practices so that we can preserve the essential qualities that reveal the mystery of Jesus' love for us in our own day, in our own stories. I thought that was a great insight to share with the priests of the diocese, and a great question for us to ask ourselves as well. How do we ensure that the mystery of the loving heart of God is found in us, personally, and, then how do we share that with the people God puts into our lives, today?

Bp. Studerus set a wonderful tone for our time together and it truly was a prayerful and enjoyable few days. It was also very nice to meet many of the priest of the diocese. As Franciscans, we typically change diocese when we are transferred so we don't get to know the other priests as well as they know themselves. Despite that, they could not have been more welcoming to us and grateful for our ministry within the diocese. Bishop O'Connell publically thanked all the Religious that serve in the Diocese of Trenton to which the crowd broke out into spontaneous applause. He recognized that the charism of each Religious community within the diocese, and that would include the Trinitarians, Society of the Divine Word, Conventual Franciscans, as well as our Franciscan communities, both friars and sisters, each add to the richness of the diocese. It was a great reminder to me that although we are one diocese, working together to build the Kingdom of God in our midst, our differences and uniqueness don't separate us but add to the richness of who we are as the Body of Christ.

Although we didn't play golf, it felt like we hit a hole in one!

Marriage: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

“October 4 is the day the Church sets aside to celebrate St. Francis of Assisi’s *dies natalis*—his birth into eternal life. Francis is easily one of the Church’s most beloved and venerated saints. Thus, even the *vigil* of his death is celebrated in style. October 3 is the *vigil* of his passing over and bears a special name - his *Transitus*. The word is derived from the Latin meaning “passage,” “crossing” or “going over.” The feast has always been an important part of Franciscan spirituality. Ideally, a Christian shouldn’t be afraid of death - or as Francis called it, “Sister Death.” Francis faced his own end with what could be described as joyful aplomb. A gentle turning to God in the final, ultimate mystery - the passing over or, the *turning over*, of one’s soul to its Lover and Author.”

Please join us on Sunday, **October 3** at **5:00 PM** in the St. Francis of Assisi Church in Brant Beach as we celebrate the *Transitus* of St. Francis. It is a beautiful and spiritually moving liturgy that includes readings from *The Life of Francis*, the Holy Gospel, hymns, and reflections. We hope you can join us. All are Welcome!
