A Letter From The Pastoral Staff..



Dear Parishioners.

This weekend we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord that brings the Christmas season to a close. It is the conclusion of one season and the beginning of another which will be Ordinary Time. The readings are well chosen and it is good to spend some time with them and read them in a personal way. By this I mean when you read the sentence in today's Gospel "You are my beloved son, with you I am well pleased", think of the fact that since you have been baptized that God is "well pleased" that you have a special relationship with Him. Hopefully, our living this out in our daily lives supports this and even when we make mistakes, God understands our humanness and that we are not perfect and are serious about our being a disciple of Jesus.

The Baptismal ceremony is a very positive experience that makes us a member of the Body of Christ. We become a sharer in Christ's light as we receive the lighted candle that has been lighted from the Paschal Candle. We are anointed with Sacred Chrism and now share in Christ's role as "priest, prophet and king." The white garment reminds us that we have become a "New creation." As infants we are not aware of the great gift that we have received through Baptism, but when we experience an adult being baptized, it strikes us that we have been given something tremendously life giving by our parents. A prayer of gratitude to them and God is appropriate.

The church season that we are entering is called Ordinary Time but nothing is "ordinary" when God is part of our lives. The Christmas season was certainly different for many people this year, but the meaning of the season was still there telling us that Jesus came into an imperfect and hostile world and that He has chosen to stay in this world because of His love and concern for us. This makes each day a gift from God and hopefully each day filled with reminders that Christ is present for each of us.



Spiritual Direction

Are you interested in a deeper relationship with God? Do you experience a desire to pray always? Are you searching for a better understanding of the actions of God's grace in your life?

Spiritual Direction is not about problem solving. It is neither counseling nor therapy. It is about enhancing one's prayer life. Directors help people recognize and respond to God's will in their life experiences. One Director summed up the process this way, "All I do is listen. People already have a spiritual life; they are not starting here. Often they need relief from the pressure that they are not doing the right thing. I help them see the goodness in where they are on their journey, not where they think they're supposed to be." God is the real spiritual director.

The Diocese of Trenton has several training programs called an internship. These are two or three year programs focusing on deepening one's own spiritual life and on learning the dynamics of Spiritual Direction. Upon completion of the program a person receives a Certificate from the Diocese.

Our parish has five certified Spiritual Directors.






