Baptism: The sacrament is celebrated three times a month at St. Francis Parish. Group Baptisms are the 2nd Saturday at 10:00 AM and the last Sunday at 12:45 PM each month at St. Francis Church in Brant Beach. Baptisms during Mass are celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of each month at the last Mass in each Church. Call the Parish Office for availability and requirements: (609) 494-8813 ext. 154 or 155.

Faith Formation and Education: For children ages six through high school. Please call Judith Clayton at (609) 494-8813 ext. 153 for more information.

Marriage: In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil

What will be different this year?

In an effort to keep our worship community safe during the Sacred Triduum, our Parish is following the directives from the Diocese of Trenton.

The dispensation from Sunday/Holy Day obligation remains in effect.

Holy Thursday:

The Mandatum (Washing of feet) is omitted. The command of love of neighbor is expressed in the washing of feet. We will have, however, a symbolic washing of feet where the priest will kneel in front of the empty chair where the feet are usually washed so that we may remember the love we have for our neighbor.

It will also remind us of the more than 500,000 people who have died in the pandemic and all those who now mourn their loved ones.

The procession with the Holy Eucharist at the conclusion of Mass is also omitted. The Holy Eucharist will be placed at an altar of repose for the Adoration of the faithful after the post-communion prayer and before the silent departure of the ministers.

Good Friday:

The reading of the Passion Narrative will take place. The Solemn intercessions will be read, not sung. People will remain at their places in the pews for the Veneration of the Cross. The priest will hold the Cross in the sanctuary and invite the people to adore the cross. There will not be any individual veneration of the Cross or any physical contact.

The Easter Vigil:

There will be no preparation or lighting of the Easter fire and no vigil candles for the congregation. The Paschal Candle will be prepared privately and lit in a dignified manner. The procession through the church will be omitted. The singing of the Exsultet will take place. The Liturgy of the Word will take place as usual. We will use the short form for the Blessing of Water and we will renew our Baptismal Promises.

This year there are no candidates for Baptism, First Communion or Confirmation.

What will not change this year or ever is our belief in the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ and in the season of Easter we will continue to live this mystery. "We will sing with the bells of heaven: Glory to God in the highest!"

Weekly Reflections...

Thin places? It's an Irish expression. A "thin place" is a spot where the separation between heaven and earth shrinks or where the boundary becomes indistinct. It is not a theological concept or church teaching, of course; just a sensation that feels true. At a thin place, God feels close and approachable. A thin place may be a mountain, a pilgrimage site, an empty beach, a soup kitchen, a hospital, a playground. Feeling the presence of God there, we experience something moving in our hearts.

Maybe there are "thin times", too. When I am called to pray with people in their last days and hours, I always feel like God is very close. The boundary between time and eternity is vanishing. Sorrowful as it is, it is a time of grace, a thin time.

Palm Sunday begins Holy Week, another thin time. God is near churning our hearts and souls as we contemplate Jesus in the days and hours that lead to the Cross.

The churning reveals the Passion of Christ continuing in the brokenness we see around us, but always with hope. And our desire to be part of what Christ does for the world grows.

Although God may not be at the forefront of our awareness at every moment, God is always present. I hope that we can feel it throughout this thin time of Holy Week and wake up changed and joyful on Easter morning.

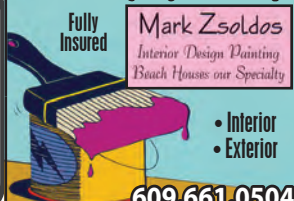
