

**Baptism**: The sacrament is celebrated three times a month at St. Francis Parish. Group Baptisms are the  $2^{nd}$ Saturday at 10:00 AM and the last Sunday at 12:45 PM each month at St. Francis Church in Brant Beach. Baptisms during Mass are celebrated on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each month at the last Mass in each Church. *Marriage:* In accordance with the Common Policy of the five Dioceses of New Jersey, arrangements must be made ONE YEAR in advance. Couples are required to attend Marriage Preparation classes. Weddings are performed on Friday or Saturday. Weddings are NOT performed on Sundays, the beach, Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Labor Day weekends.

# Did You Know??

Did you know that St Francis Parish and Long Beach Island Community Center (St Francis Center) are both qualifying employers under the federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program (PSLF)?

Both companies are 501c3 tax exempt organizations according to the IRS. 
